Why is it Hard?

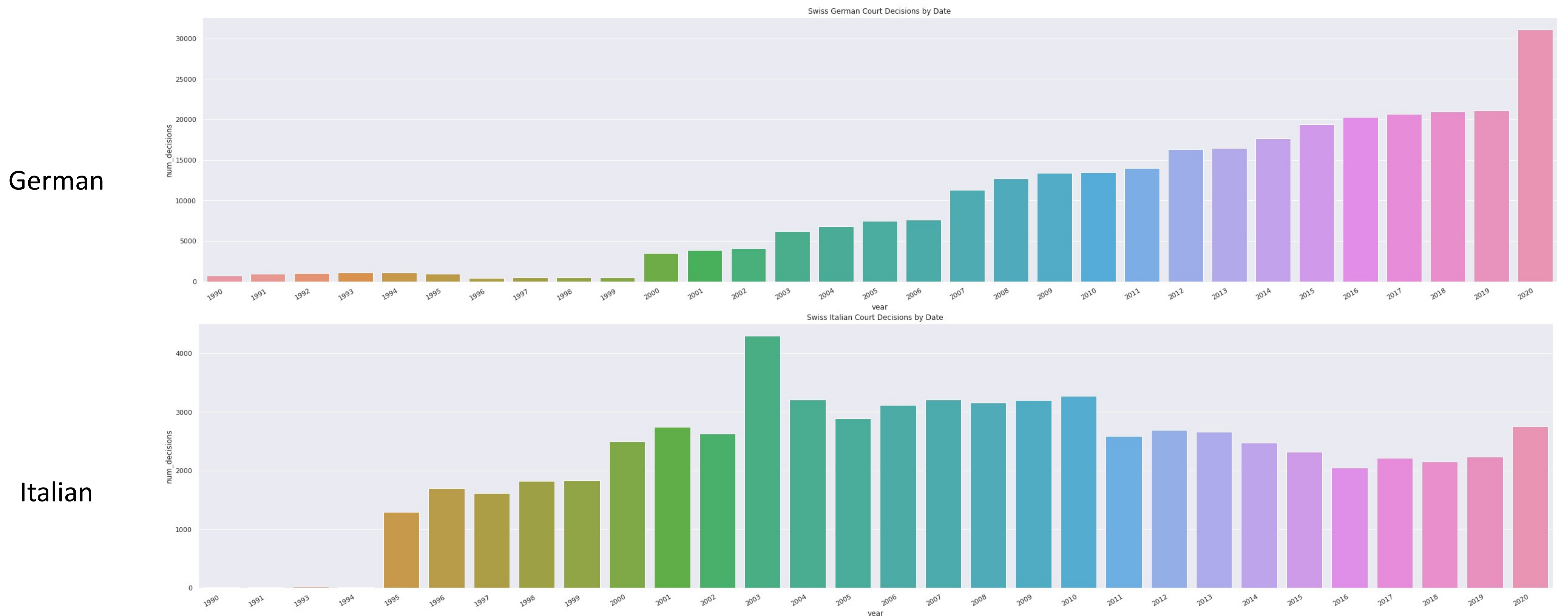
Large volume of text needs

Why Should One Care?

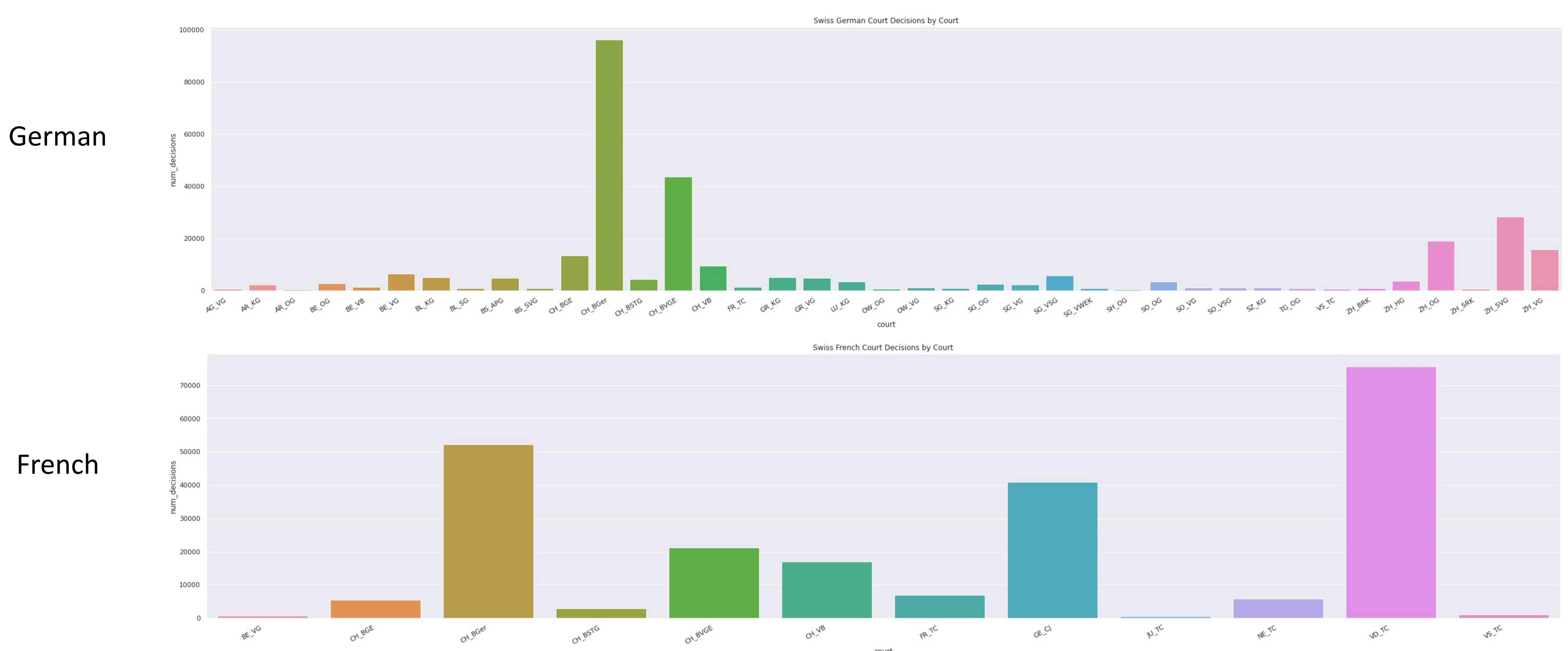
This dataset is the first step for
