The data include year- and age specific reported catches, survey indices, and maturity ogives for nine fish species found in the Barents Sea (see article for details). Each file contains one kind of data for one species.

Reported catches are given as number of caught individuals by age (columns) and year (rows). Survey indices are given as number of individuals by age (columns) and year (rows). Maturity ogives are given as proportion of mature individuals by age (columns) and year (rows).

All data for the species *Gadus Morhua*, *Melanogrammus aeglefinus*, *Pollachius virens*, *Sebastes mentella*, *Sebastes marinus*, and *Reinhardtius hippoglossoides* are found in ICES 2008a.

All data for the species *Micromesistius poutassou* and *Clupea harengus* are found in ICES 2008b.

For *Mallotus villosus*, the survey indices are found in ICES 2009, the maturity ogives in ICES 2008a (see article for details), whereas reported catches were provided by Institute of Marine Research.
