



A CV is a professional document chronicling your professional and academic history and experiences


Short for curriculum vitae (Latin)

Sharing

CVs can be shared online on a website or other digital mediums. These helps give broader audiences an idea of your work

Person Record

A personal version of a CV is a great way to keep track of what you have accomplished for yourself and future opportunities as it is easy to forget
