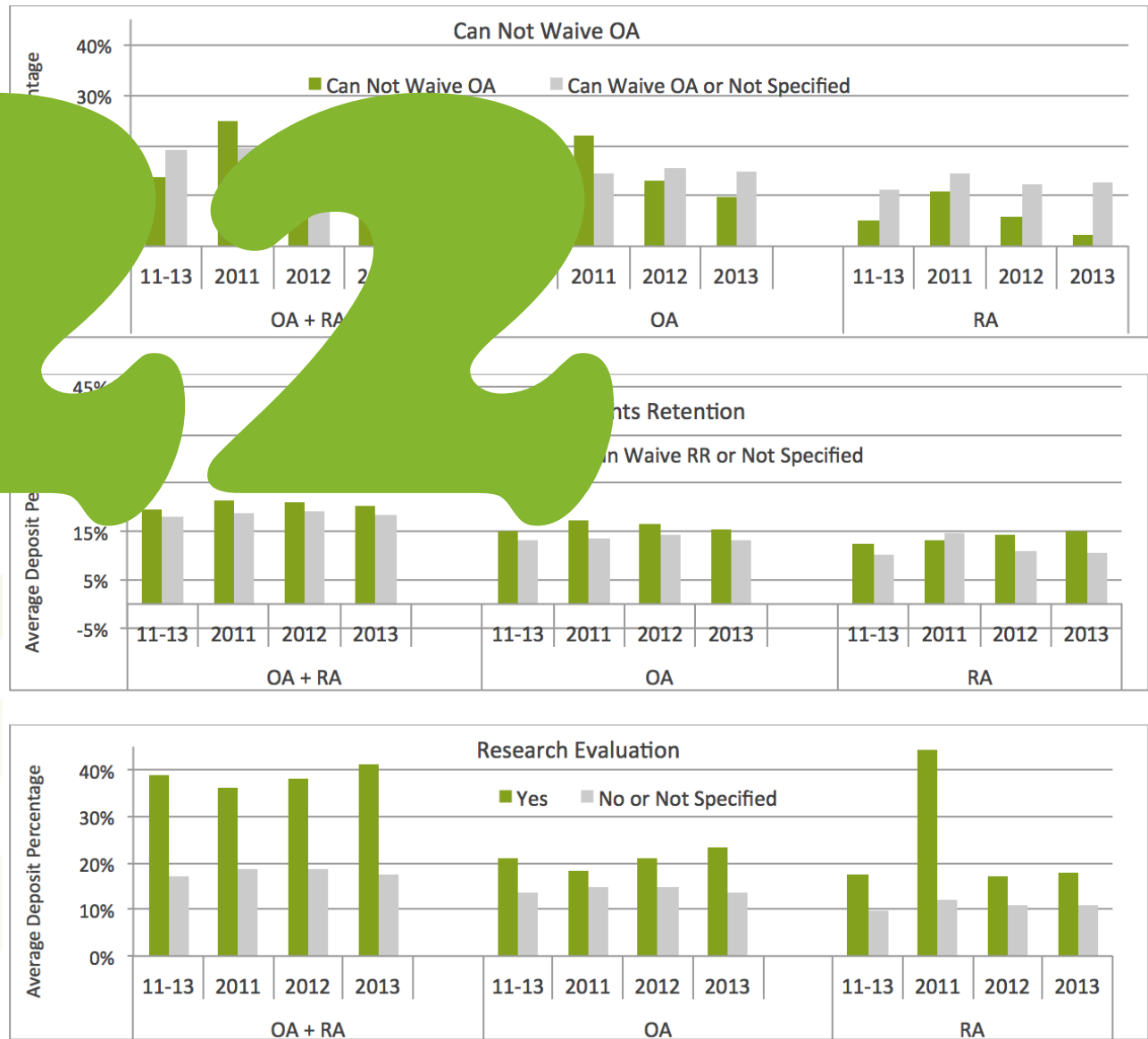

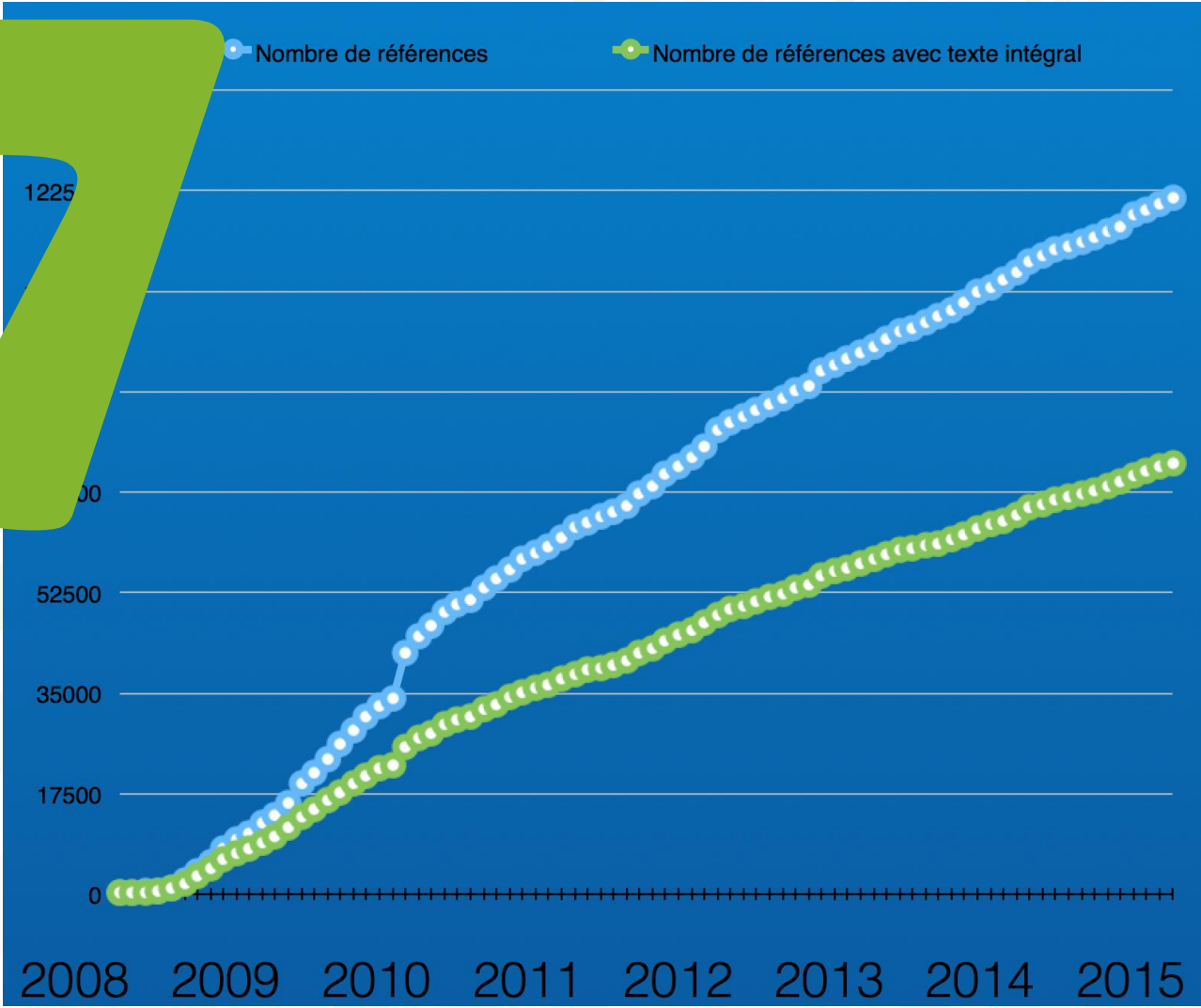

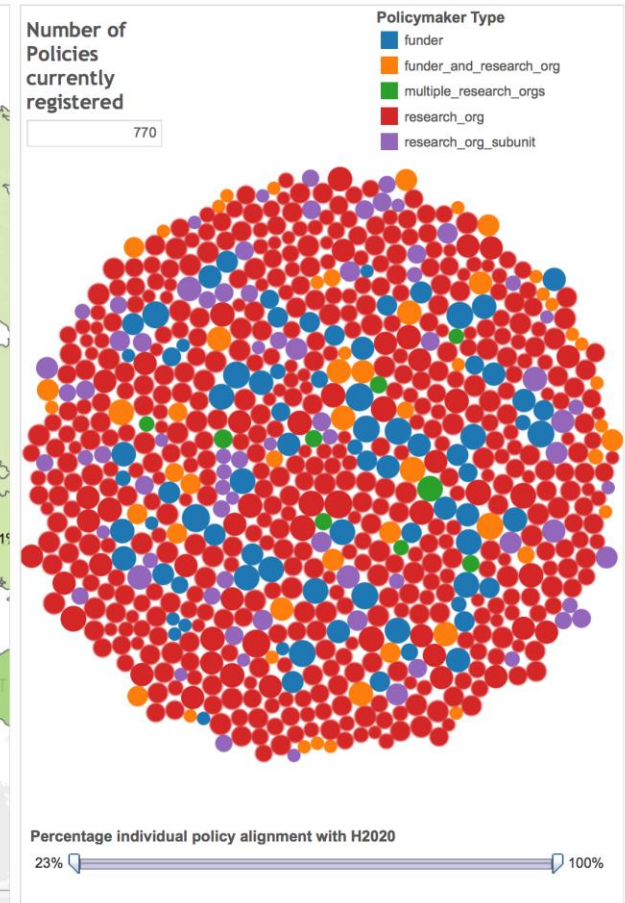


Alignment to the Horizon 2020 Open Access Policy

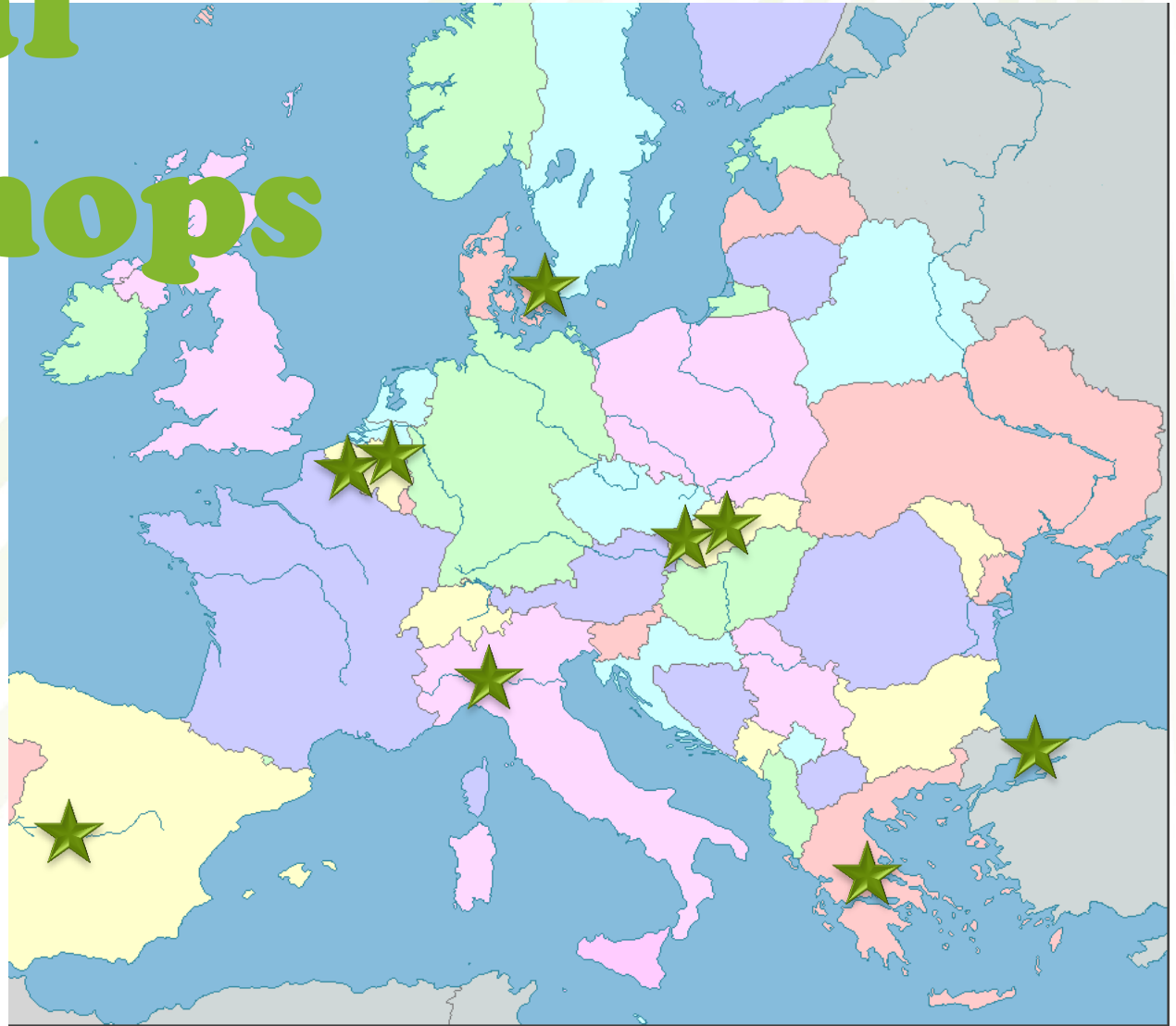
