#### Research Data Services and Tools

- Joint efforts to develop interconnected infrastructures for Research Data.
  - Hellenic Data Service "HELIX" (https:// hellenicdataservice.gr/main/)
  - University data repositories "HARDMIN" (https://hardmin.heal-link.gr)





#### OpenAIRE effect

- Open Science compliant institutional repositories (literature and data).
- Argos for machine actionable DMPs.
- Amnesia for anonymization of data.











# support services

#### Librarians

- Prepare material for librarians to promote OA and OS.
- Establish a help-desk about OA options; further support with two tools:
  - inventory of eligible OA journals.
  - listing of publishers' options.
- Monitor and report about the progress of HEAL-Link Open Access programmes (https://scholarly.heal-link.gr/monitoring/).








#### Researchers

- Supporting material: e.g. translation of the Open Research Europe guidelines, OpenAIRE factsheets.




## skills & awareness

#### Librarians

- Upskilling and reskilling the research support workforce -> emphasis on RDM.
- Engage with the OA Monographs community to highlight the state and the opportunities in the Greek context.

#### Researchers

Wide number of events on the developments and best practices for Open Access options, Research Data Management and Data Management Plans, EOSC, Open Research Europe, etc.

#### National level

 Co-development of the proposal for a Greek National Open Science Plan (https://doi.org/10.5281/zenodo.3908953).

#### Institutional level

Co-development of policy templates that promote the FAIR principles in a uniform way.

- Series of webinars and training events that facilitated productive discussions and synergies by presenting:
  - clinical trials and studies,
  - national research infrastructures for computing data for fighting Covid-19,
  - tools that facilitate data management and analysis, such as Argos, OpenRefine, Galaxy, etc.,
  - tools that estimate the bibliographic impact of research publications, such as BIP! Finder.
- Monitor and report about the Greek OA publications on Covid-19.
