

#### Open / FAIR data since 2016

Research data resulting from NWO-funded projects should be made available for reuse

- "As open as possible, closed if necessary"
- Findable, Accessible, Interoperable, Reusable

#### RDM Policy: two pronged approach

#### **Data Management Section**

Four questions in grant application forms to encourage researchers to think about research data management at the proposal stage.

Not (yet) included in grant assessment.

#### **Data Management Plan**

Required for all awarded projects. To be submitted no later than 4 months after the project has been awarded. The project will start as soon as NWO has approved the DMP.



#### International alignment of Research Data Management

NWO championed the alignment of RDM policies among research funders in Europe.

NWO was one of the first organisations to implement the Science Europe core requirements for DMPs and actively promotes these requirements to other stakeholders.





#### What is the level of compliance with our policy?

#### **Open**

How many published datasets underlie publications funded by NWO?

#### **FAIR**

When datasets cannot be shared under an open license, is metadata made publicly available?

#### **Repositories**

Where are datasets/metadata deposited and deposited? Are these trustworthy repositories with PID provision, licenses, long-term preservation of data and metadata?



#### **NWO Persistent Identifier Strategy**

To improve the capacity for analyzing the impact of the research we fund, NWO will implement ORCID, ROR and Grant-Ids in the next few years.

## maDMPs

Promise to allow the exchange of information across research tools and systems, which in turn will enable parts of the DMP to be automatically generated and shared.

Individual DMPs would act as a hub to project-level research outputs, and aggregations of DMPs as hubs to research more generally, including to planned or ongoing research and to research infrastructure.
