


Number of Bibliographies per Continent

(n=48)





Cooperative Structures Supporting the NBA (n=43)








Types of Print Resources Included in the National Bibliography

Resource Type Inclusion


Types of Non-Print Resources Included in the National Bibliography (excluding online)




Online Access Methods for National Bibliography Metadata



Data Formats Offered for Metadata Downloads








