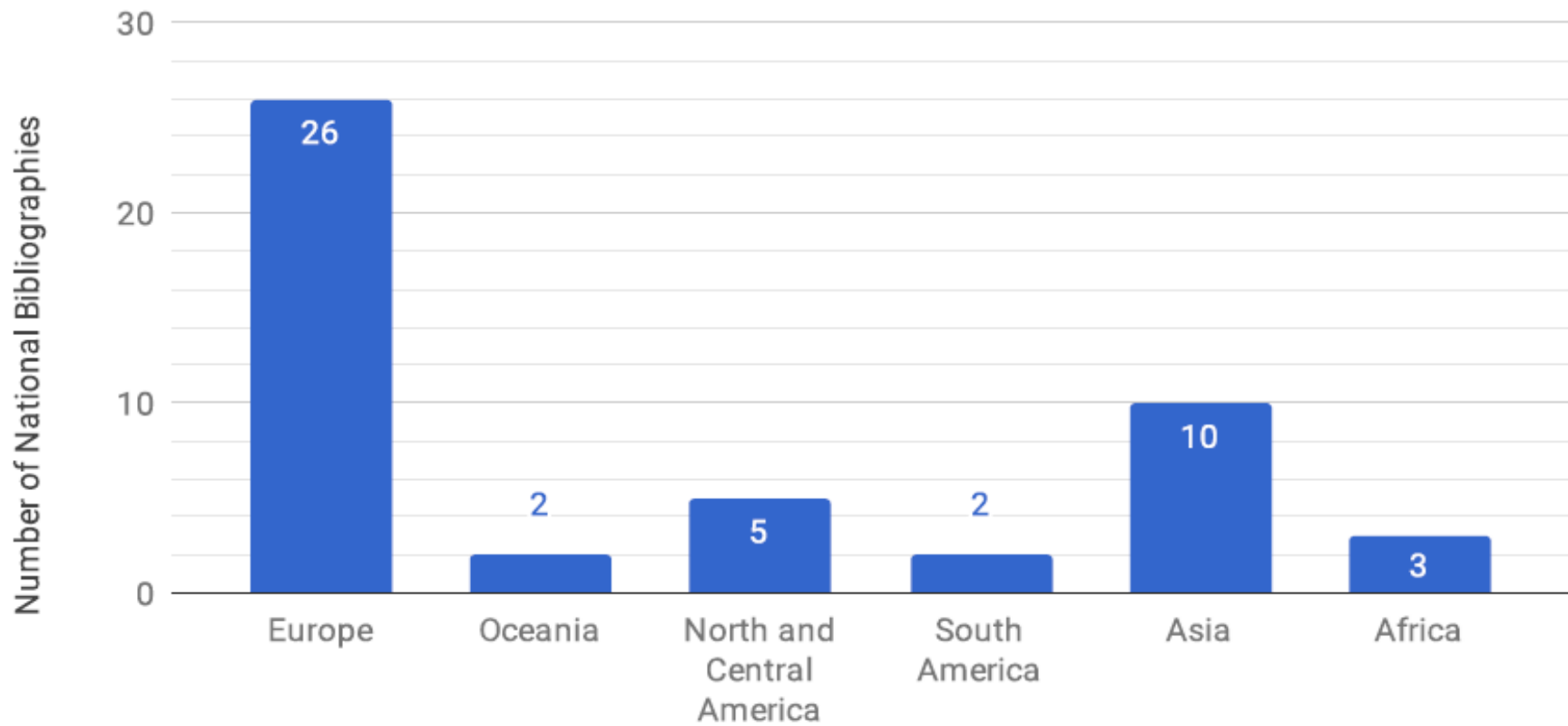

Number of Bibliographies per Continent

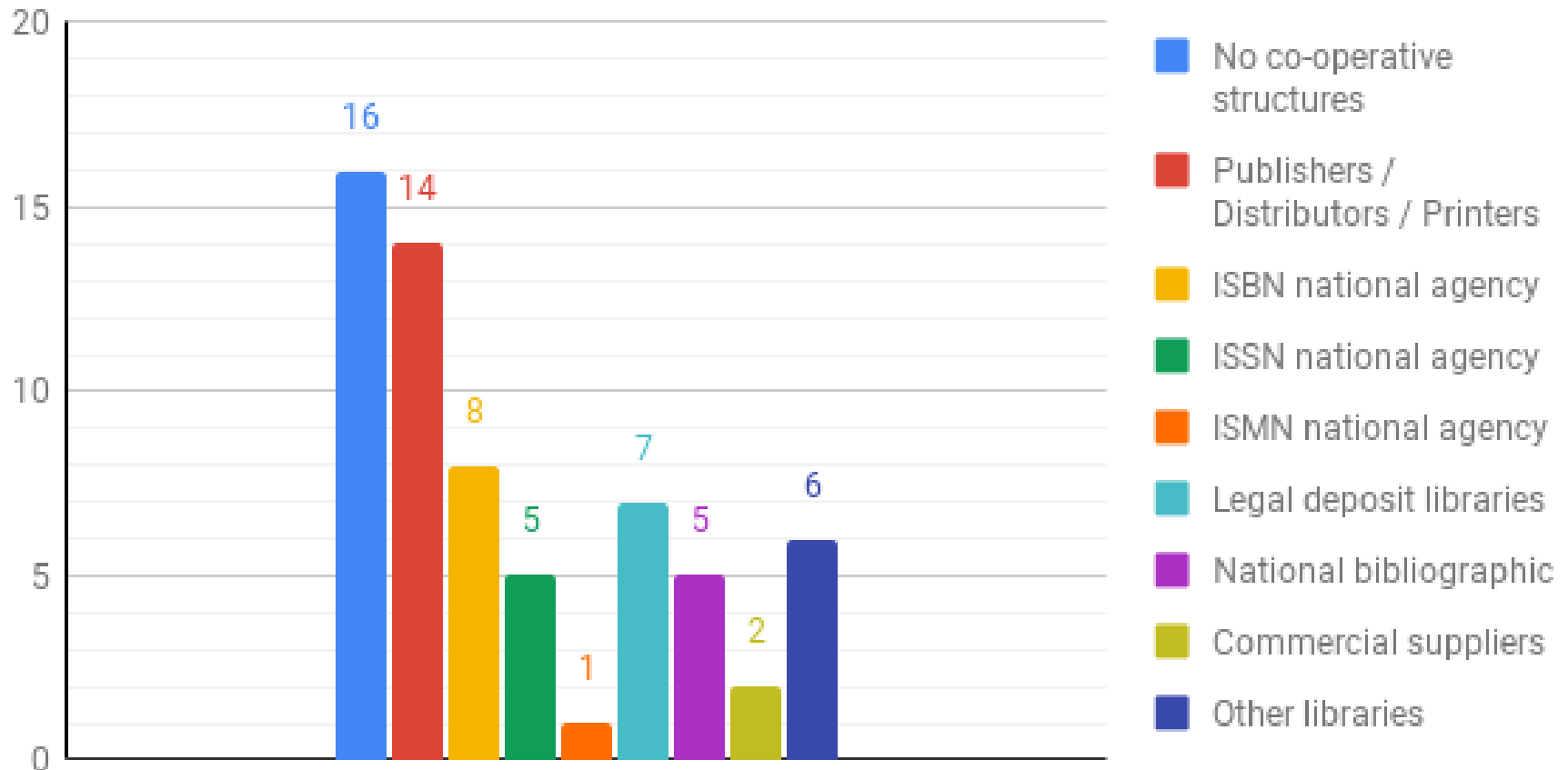

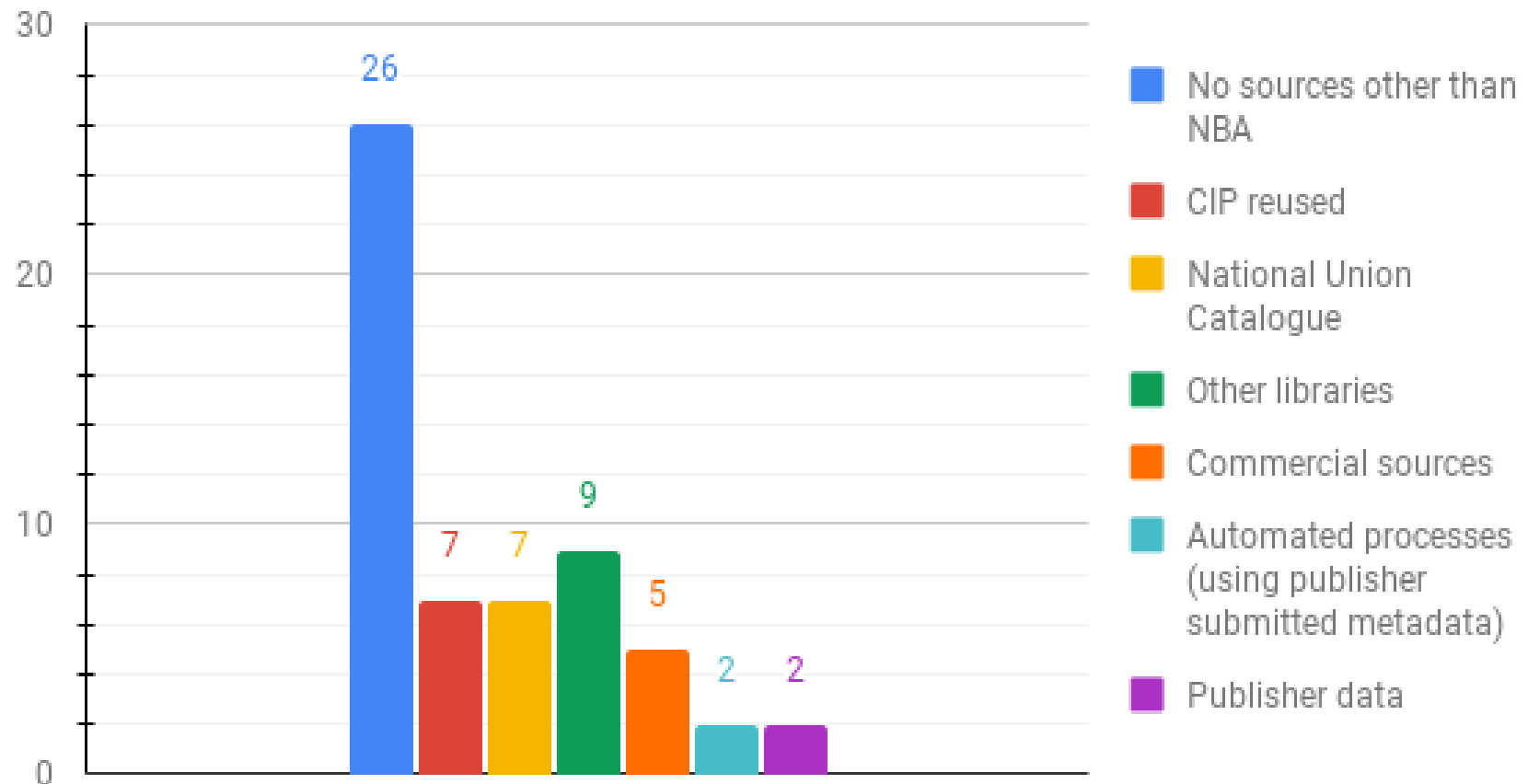

## Sources of Bibliographic Metadata (in addition to NBA)

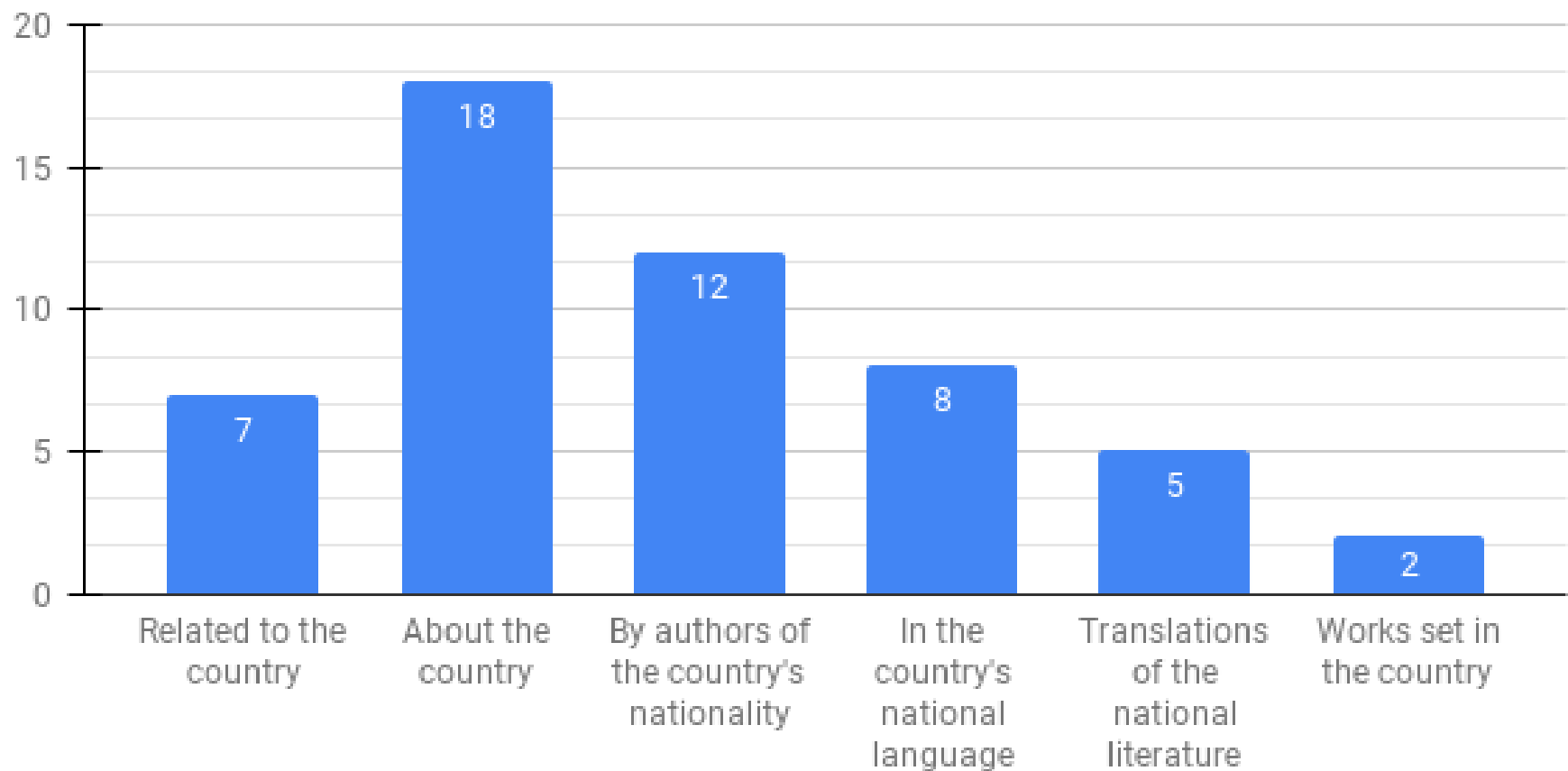

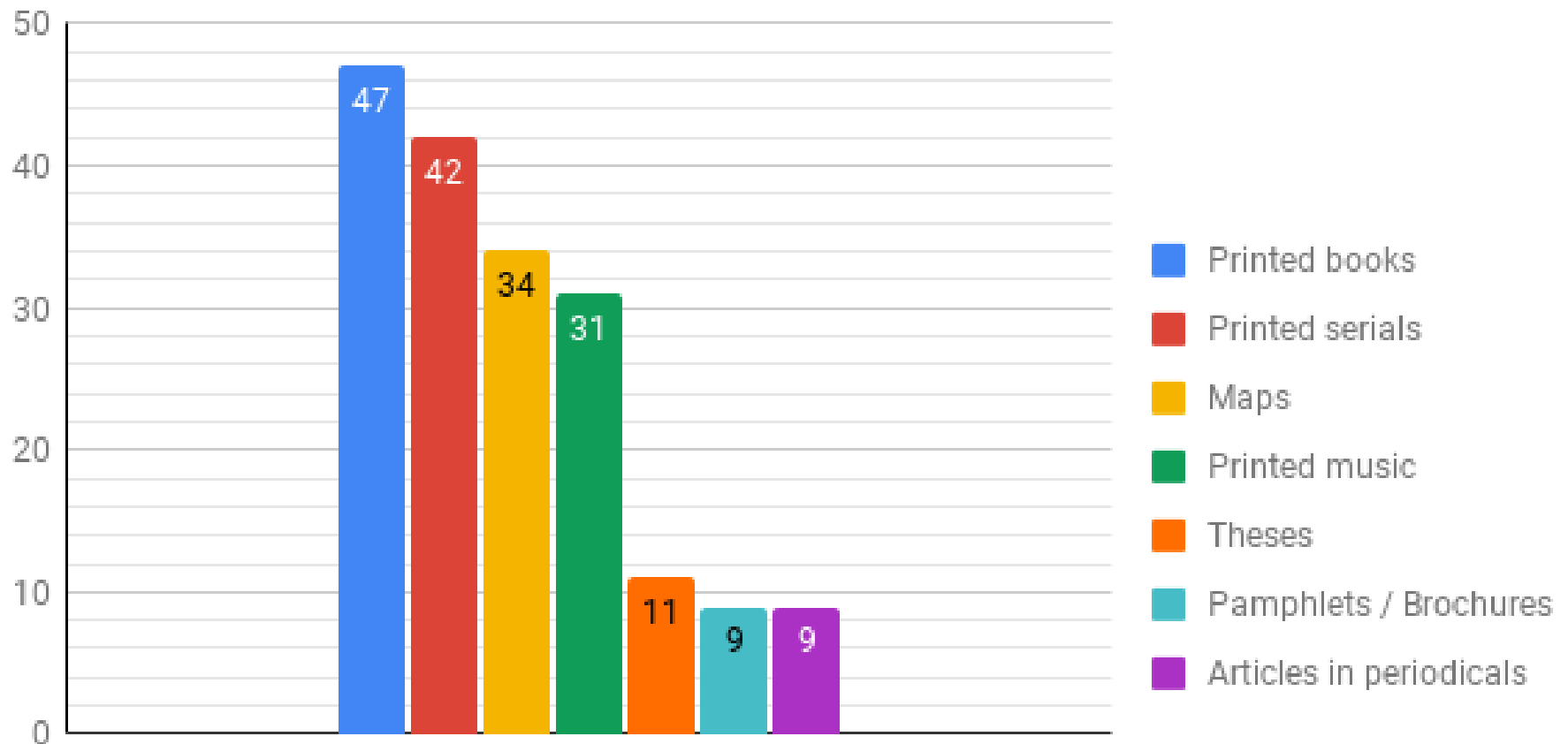

(n=47)

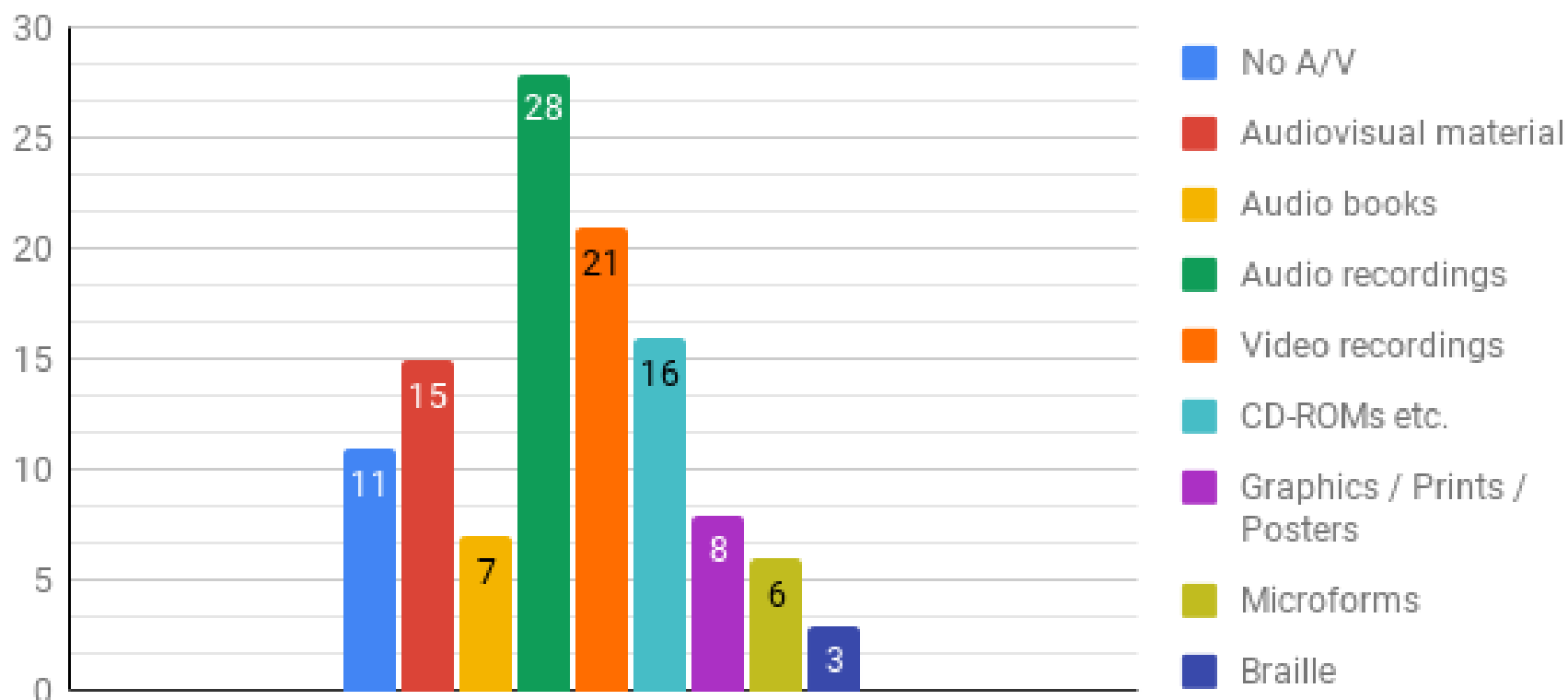

Types of Non-Print Resources Included in the National Bibliography (excluding online)

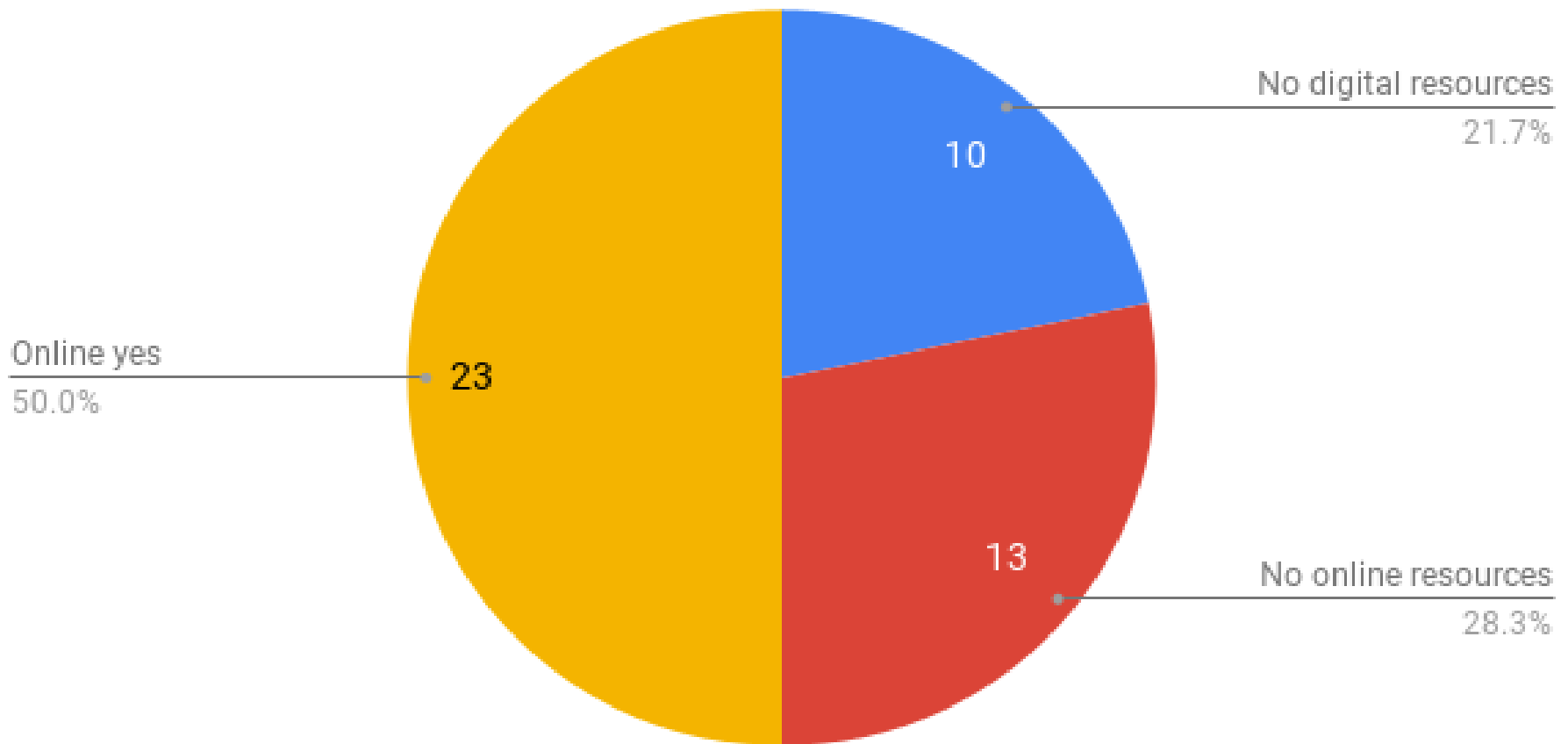

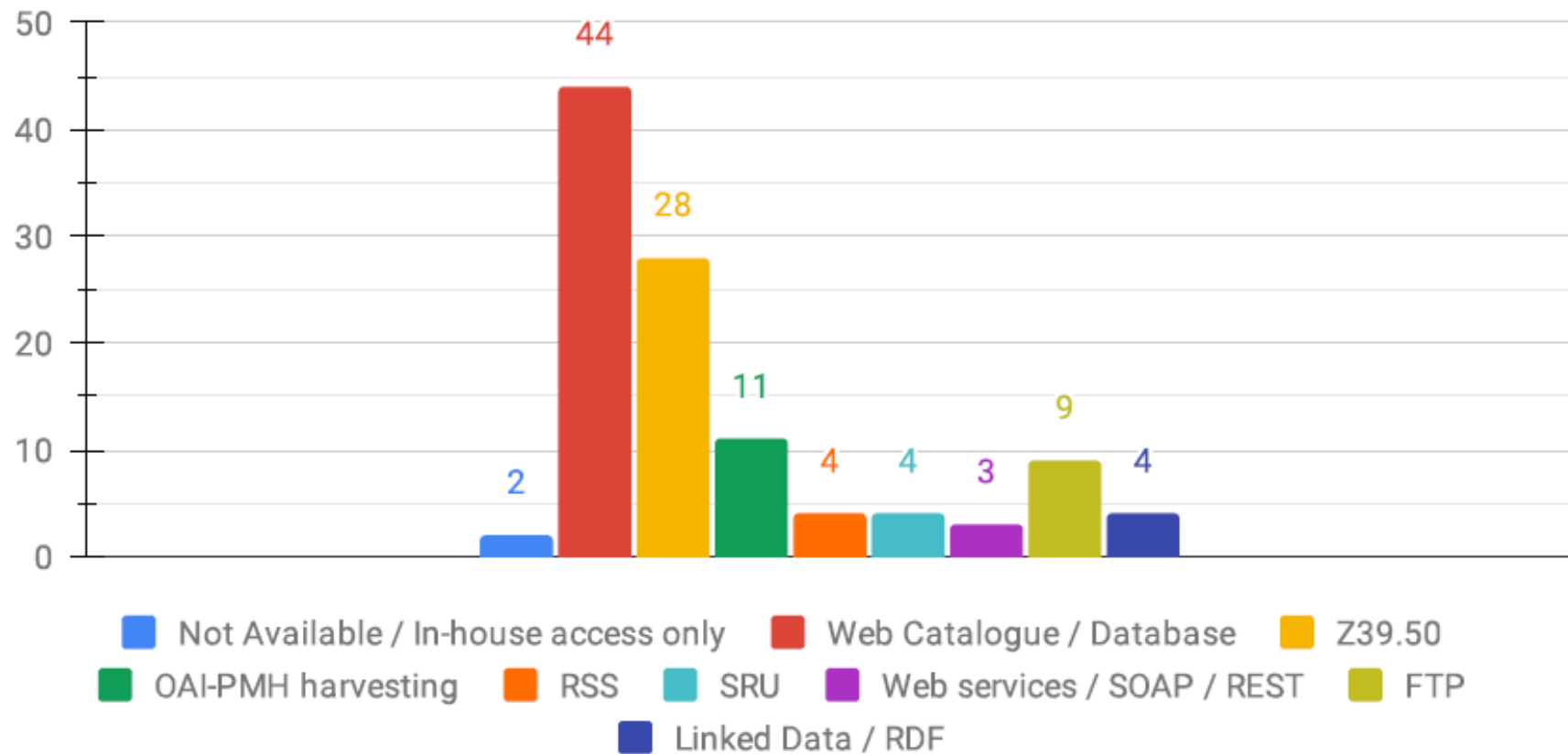

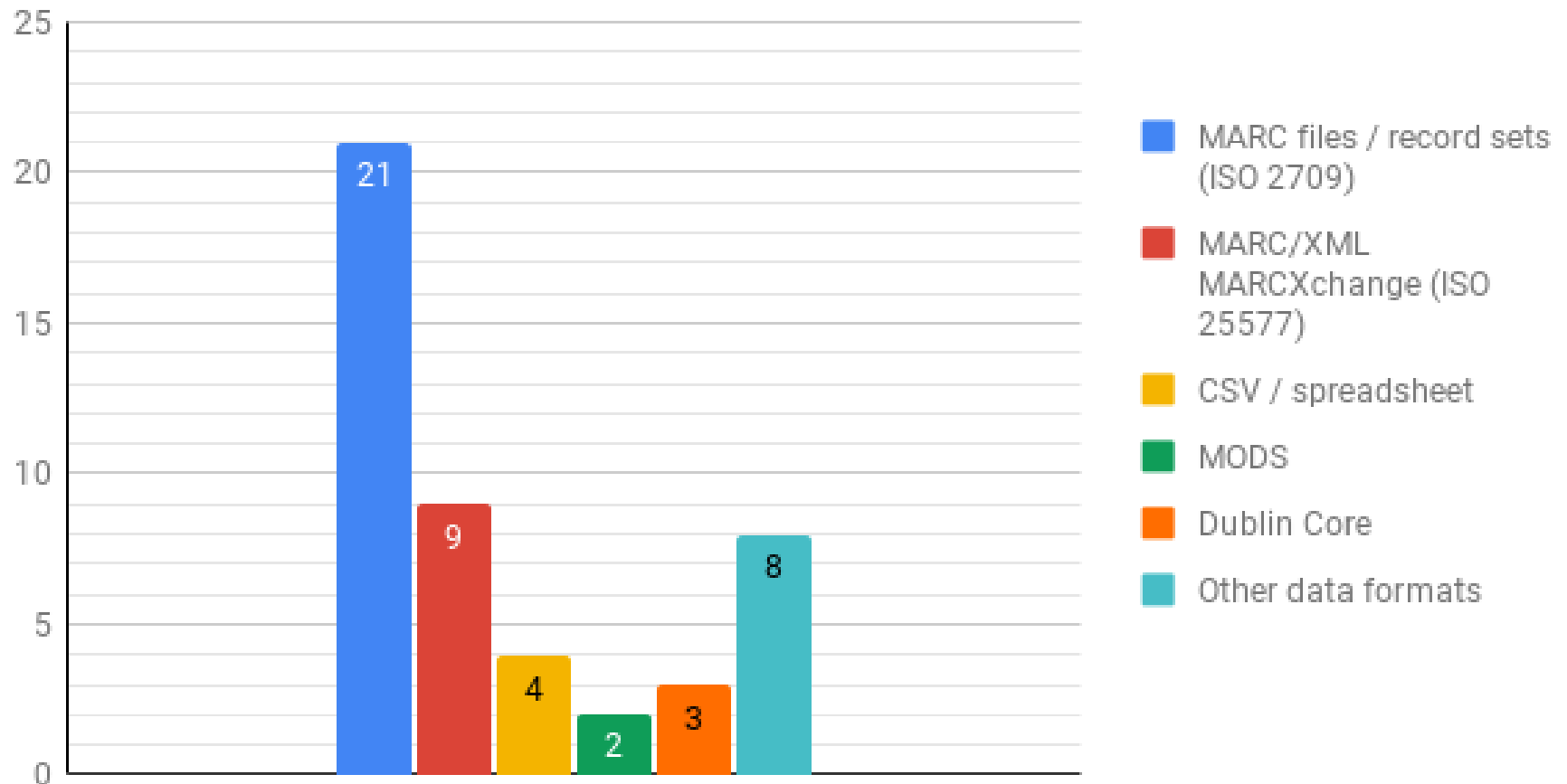
## Online Access Methods for National Bibliography Metadata

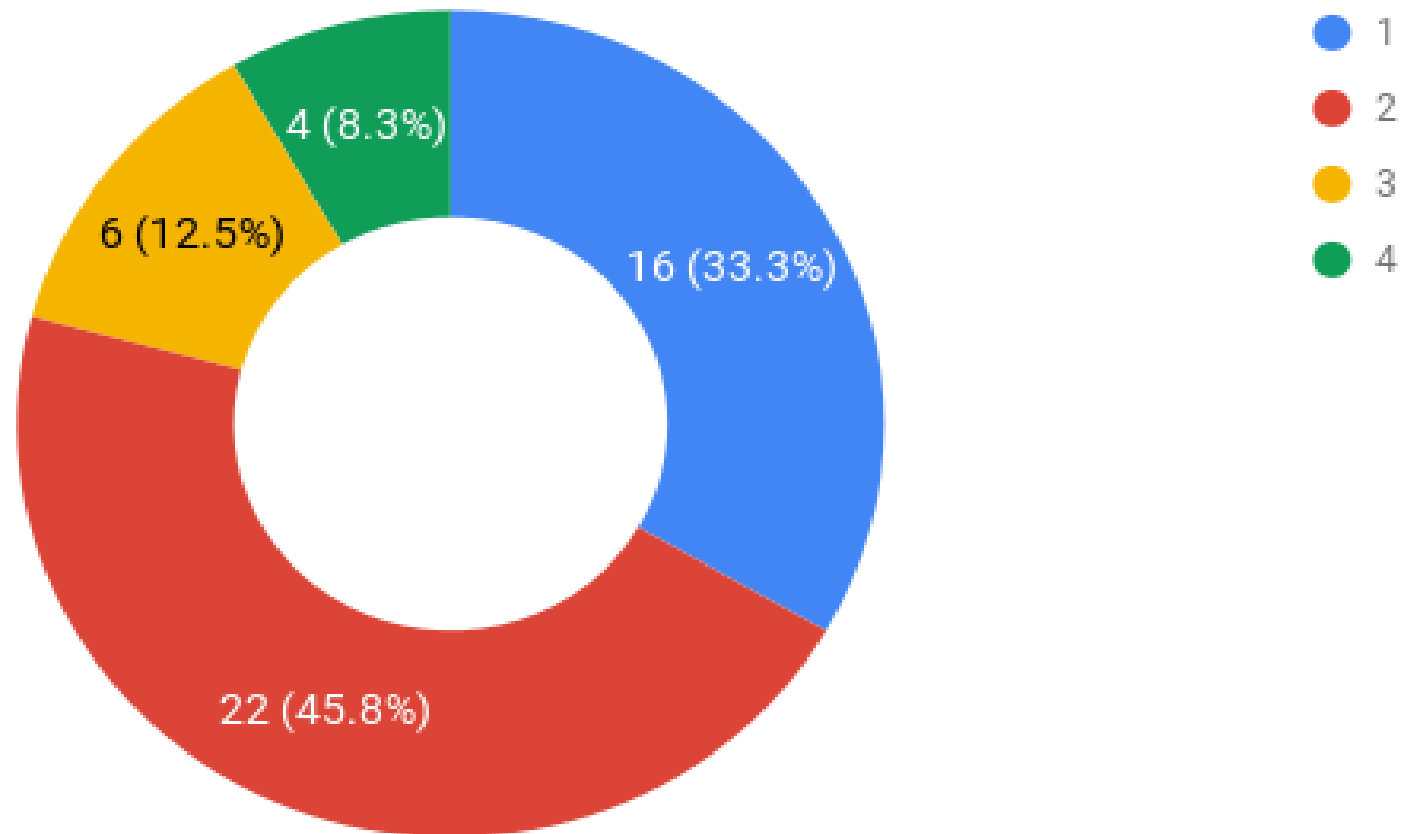
Data Formats Offered for Metadata Downloads

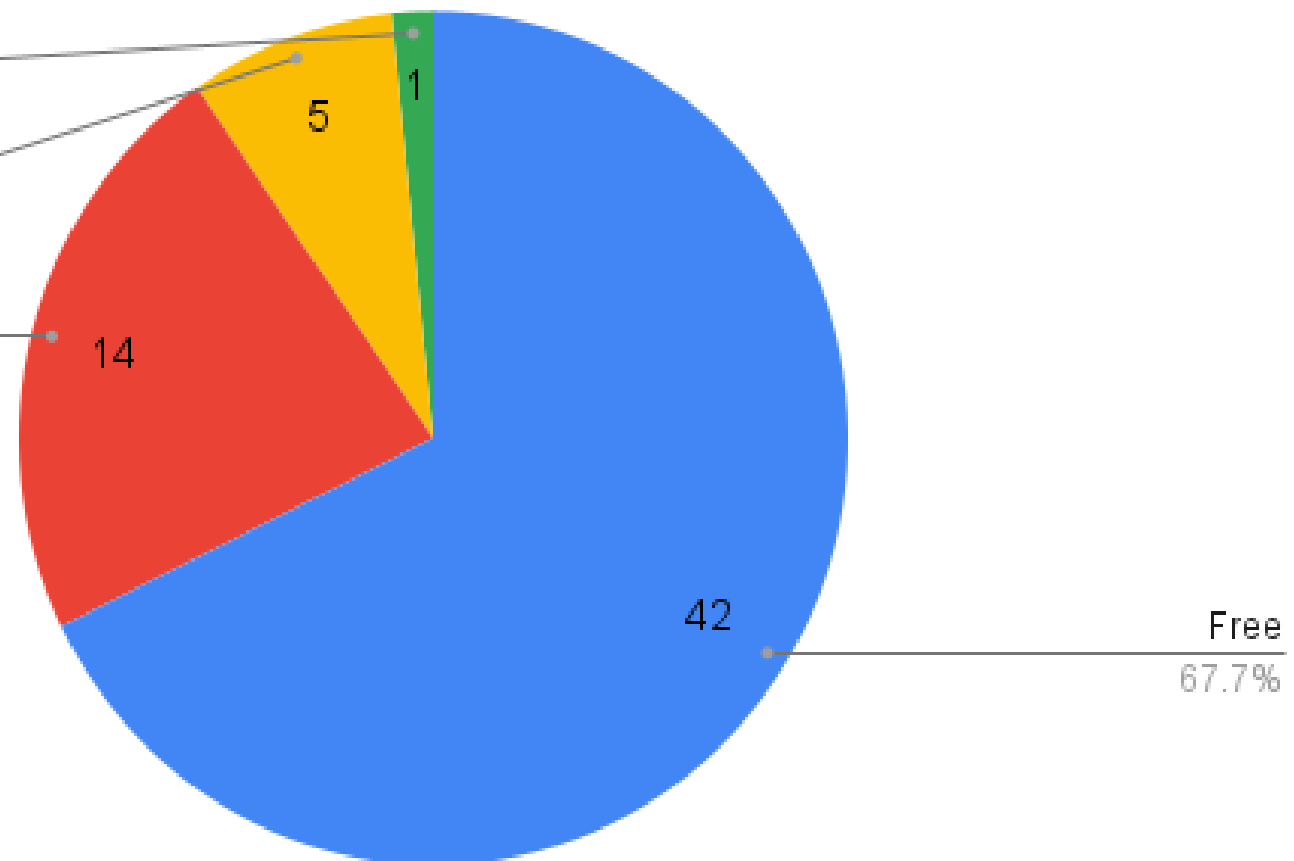

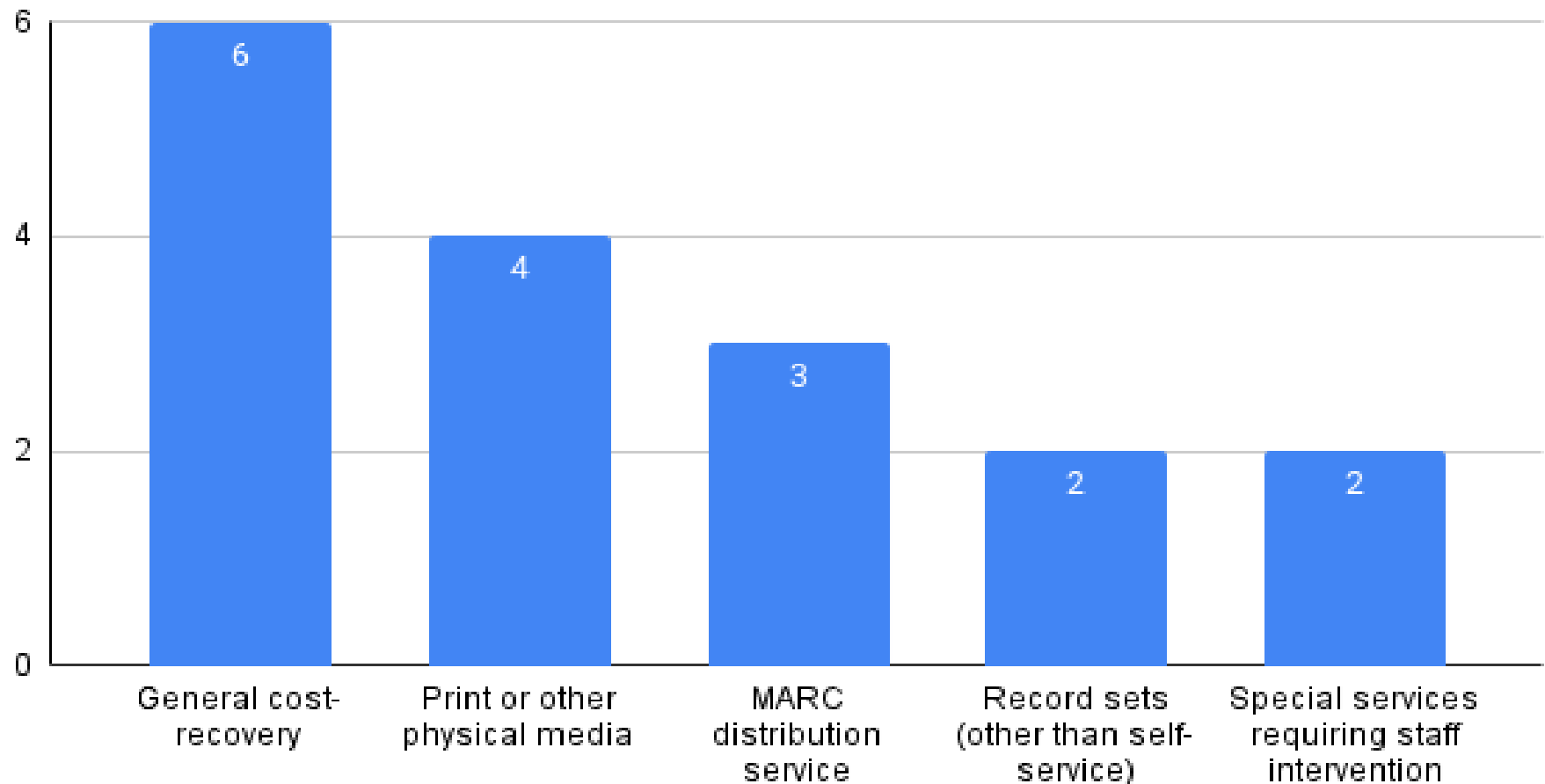

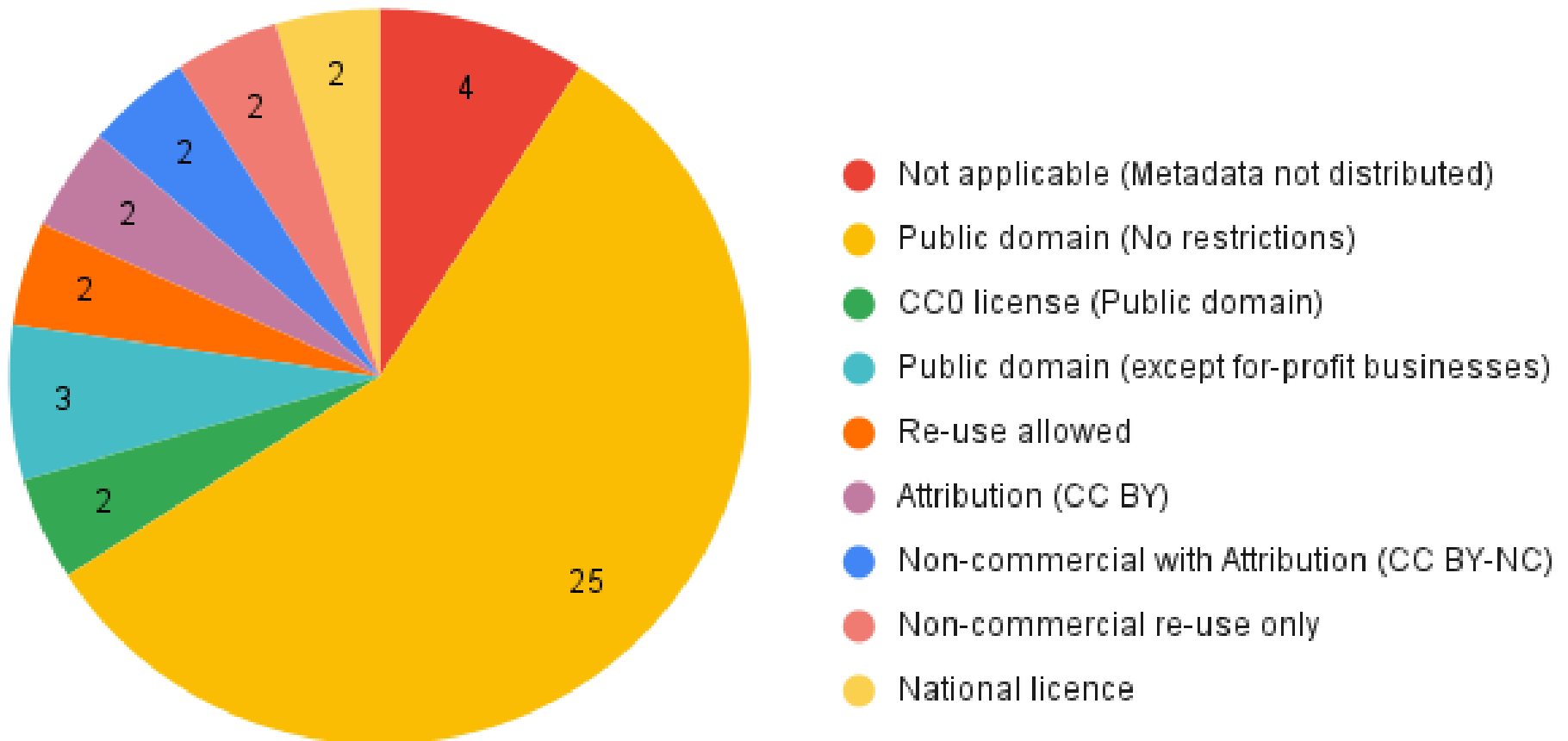
