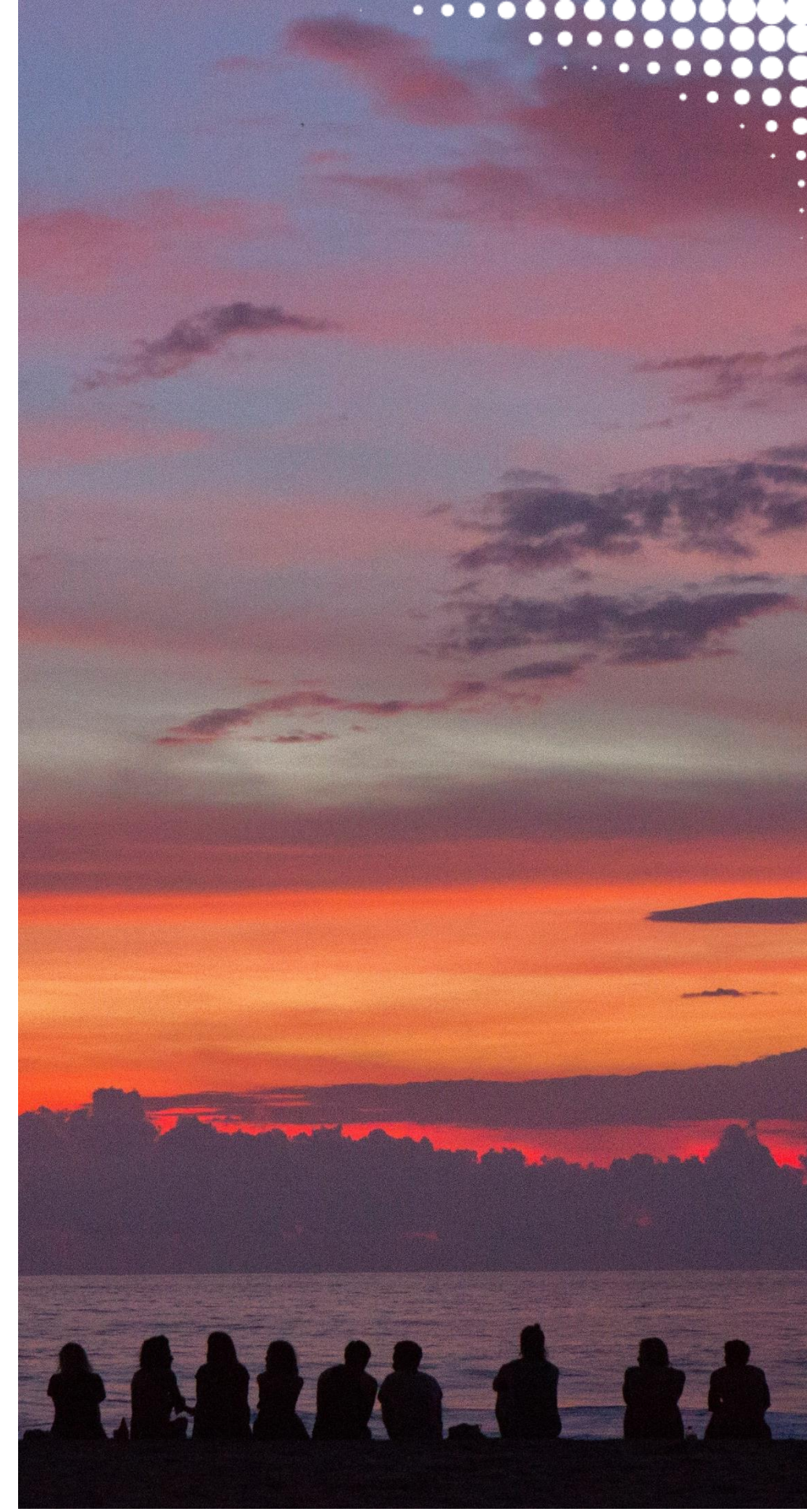

FAIR assessment in OpenAIRE Validator

Discover the new functionality to evaluate the FAIRness of your datasource

The FAIR assessment of datasources is available in the OpenAIRE Validator since June 2021. This service, still in beta, is being developed by the OpenAIRE Content Providers. It's already available to be used and tested by the OpenAIRE Content Providers.

We would like to invite datasource managers to use and test this service. We invite them to evaluate the level of adoption of the FAIR Principles by their datasources.

The Validator is available to every logged-in user via the PROVIDER interface. It is intended to provide an impression of the FAIRness of their datasources.

This is the result of the ongoing work of OpenAIRE to adapt the FAIR Model indicators in our OpenAIRE Validator.

The FAIR Maturity Model Indicators, as core criteria to assess the implementation of the FAIR (Data) principles, implemented in the OpenAIRE Validator, will allow datasource managers, a way to assess the implementation of FAIR in their datasources. This implementation in the Validator will allow to evaluate the level of adoption of the FAIR Principles by datasources.

In close cooperation with regional and national partners, COAR is launching an international strategy to help repositories embrace their new and expansive role in the scholarly communications landscape.

This strategy, launched on July 6, 2021 with the collaboration of key partners in each region and country, proposes individualized plans for each participating country and region that will be highly tailored to the local context and address each country's most salient and acute challenges.
