


Priorities

 - Need contiguous redundant capability







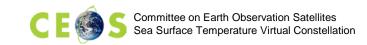




G-XVI: We met at ESTEC

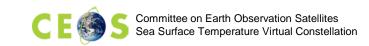
