TECHNOLOGY & ENDANGERED LANGUAGES

- What if technology can disrupt language bias?

- Colonization has caused thousands of language communities to become disenfranchised.
 - Most countries are not investing in resources needed to support minority languages.



We aim to obviate institutionalized barriers that prevent equal status and equitable treatment of all forms of linguistic communication.


