Ngozi is concerned about

Consequences of the Covid-19 pandemic and the lockdown in the communities for the livelihood of the people because of:

- Deserted farmland and market stands
- People without income
- Hunger
- Spoilt crops and wares

She argues for

- a) ICT facilities and skills to support (first-hand) online information on:
 - Policies relating to their livelihoods
 - Crops availability and prices
 - Information about contacts for supply and packaging
- b) Cooperation and collaboration initiatives among community members for negotiation and distribution of goods

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
