SQ4R – an effective reading strategy

SQ4R is a method of studying textbooks. It's an acronym for: Survey, Question, Read, Respond, Record, and Review. When using this method, complete all the steps initially, then choose which are most effective for you and your courses. The SQ4R method may seem time consuming at first, but once you know the steps, it only takes a few minutes.

Step 1: Survey the Textbook and Chapters

Step 2: Start with a Question

Step 3: Read Actively

Step 4: Respond to Your Question

Step 5: Record Your Notes

Step 6: Review Your Notes
