Introducing the EMM Survey Registry!

A new tool for discovering and learning about quantitative surveys on the integration and inclusion of ethnic and migrant minorities (EMM)

The <u>EMM Survey Registry</u>—which has been co-created by <u>COST Action 16111 -</u> <u>ETHMIGSURVEYDATA</u>, the H2020 project <u>SSHOC</u>, and the ANR project <u>FAIRETHMIGQUANT</u> is a free online tool for discovering and learning about existing quantitative surveys undertaken with EMM (sub) populations in Europe and beyond. This tool not only brings together previously scattered information about these surveys but also offers detailed and structured metadata for each of the surveys. Designed with the end-users in mind, this tool can also easily be leveraged by anyone interested in doing research or policy-related work using quantitative surveys on EMMs' integration and inclusion.

The EMM Survey Registry is **currently live and available in beta version**. This version is **fully functional and displays metadata for over 1200 surveys from 25 different countries**. The tool has also already **welcomed 300-400 unique users each month** from all over the globe and from different disciplines, sectors, industries, etc. Moreover, it aspires to showcase survey research on EMMs in 30 European and neighbouring countries.

In the coming months, an **additional 100-200 surveys will be added** to the EMM Survey Registry covering additional countries. **Survey producers will also be invited to contribute their own metadata** (for free but with quality supervision) to help expand the metadata collection of the registry, as well as share their research with an international audience.

Creating a COVID-19 collection: contribute to the EMM Survey Registry



Since the start of the pandemic in 2020, **a growing number of COVID-19 surveys have been conducted with EMMs all across the world**, either targeting these minorities as the main focus of the survey or within general population surveys with boost samples. As these surveys can **provide meaningful insights about the COVID-19 experience for EMMs, the EMM Survey Registry will be curating a special COVID-19 collection!** We are therefore calling on all the survey research community to contribute to this public resource that will make COVID-19 surveys covering the EMM populations findable and

If you are **a data producer who is currently developing or has already completed a COVID-19 survey that includes EMM respondents** (a sample of at least 250 individuals), you can contribute metadata about your survey directly to the EMM Survey Registry by following the steps below:

- Send an email to <u>sshoc.project@sciencespo.fr</u> with the subject line, "COVID-19 survey," to express your interest in contributing metadata about your survey. In the body of the email, please provide the name of your survey as well as some general information about your survey (country and locations where conducted, sample sizes, which minorities included, timing, etc.).
- Fill out an <u>application form</u> to request an account that will grant you access to an online form for contributing metadata.

Once both of these steps have been completed, the administrators of the EMM Survey Registry will be in touch via email to discuss the next steps.

Please note that you will **not be asked to add any micro-data or survey findings** to the EMM Survey Registry; you will only share information about the technical characteristics of the survey. If you have already made the data available in a repository or archive, you will be able to provide links to the deposited data or to any publications you wish to share with the public. All COVID-19 surveys that are captured on the EMM Survey Registry will have **their metadata publicly displayed**. These surveys will also be **searchable using the keyword '<u>COVID-19</u>**'.
