


PROBLEMS OF TRANSLATING REALITIES

It is natural that it does not comply with the principles of method. This Transcription method maximizes the pronunciation of the original reality to the translated text is given as an approximation. For example, the Russian word pelmeni is in Bulgarian given in the form of pelmeni. Not to mention a single softening sign almost no changes as a result of transcription.
