- Time! For repository management, consultations, event planning, etc.

Lessons

- Important to establish ourselves as "point people" for specific areas - not unicorns
- General/introductory support was valued over extreme expertise in this early stage
- Embrace institutional context in developing Open Science initiatives
- Identify Open Science areas to focus on by what is most unclear to researchers
- Find hidden Open Science skills of colleagues
