3) executive - sound and intonational design of thought (at the initial stage of training, the transition of the utterance program to its execution occurs through the native language;

4) controlling, the task of which is to signal possible errors and contribute to their correction; control implies that the speaker has a standard, which is formed as a result of language practice and comparison of one's own speech with the standard.

For teaching speaking, special exercises are designed, divided into preparatory and speech. Skills and abilities of unprepared speech, its reactivity, spontaneity, theme - are developed in dialogue; the skills and abilities of a prepared speech with its initiative, logic, consistency - in a monologue.

Dialogic speech is a form of speech in which there is a direct exchange of statements between two or more persons. The conditions in which dialogical speech proceeds determine a number of its features, which include: brevity of the utterance, the widespread use of non-verbal means of communication (facial expressions, gestures), the great role of intonation, the variety of special sentences of incomplete composition, the syntactic design of the utterance free from the strict norms of book speech, the predominance of simple sentences.

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
