

COUNTER CoP R5 Updates: Metric Types

- Total Item Requests: Counts all article full-content views across all formats like HTML and PDF. This is equivalent to the Release 4 usage count.
- Unique Item Requests: Counts unique article full-content views in a given session regardless of format. If a user views an article PDF and HTML in the same session this would only count as 1.
- **Total Item Investigations**: Counts total number of times information related to an article viewed (including all article full-content views).
- Unique Item Investigations: Counts unique article investigations and requests in a user-session.

COUNTER CoP R5: Example Scenario

Susan is researching the history of Porto in UMINHO repository. From a list of search results, she opens three article abstracts. The counts are:

- total item investigations: 3
- unique item investigations: 3

After reading the abstracts, Susan downloads the PDFs for two of the articles. The counts change to:

- total_item_investigations: 5 (3 as "views" + 2 as "downloads")
- unique item investigations: 3 (3 unique "views")
- total item requests: 2
- unique item requests: 2


