Call for the exclusion of not-for-profit repositories, digital archives and libraries from the obligations of the Digital Services Act

Statement by Research Organisations, Libraries, Repositories and University Networks

COAR and other European organisations (representing European u RFOs, research libraries and repositories in Europe) signed a joint state exclusion for not-for-profit repositories, digital archives and libraries from the Digital Services Act (DSA).

The Digital Services Act aims to regulate social media and other conten and provide a legal instrument that can address the spread of ill misinformation. Unfortunately there is a risk that this legislation will a repositories and other research and education infrastructures.
