## Overview

This is a codebook for the dataset of parties active in the National Assembly of Serbia. Data were collected from the website of the National Assembly [link] and Otvoreni parlament [link] and further populated using publicly available sources. The dataset covers the period of 1997-2020 and counts eight terms with 167 party-entries and one broad coalition - Democratic opposition of Serbia (DOS). We decided to include DOS as a data entry on its own as many MPs declared their party affiliation to the coalition rather than the parties that originally nominated them.

## Variables

The dataset contains 14 variables. The following overview presents all of them. Each variable is accompanied by a data type - [character] for a string of text and [numeric] for numbers.

## codeparty

Unique code assigned to a party; can be used for merging the corpus data with the meta-information collected on parties. [character]

#### term1

Term duration. [yyyy-yyyy]

#### term2

Official numeric denominator for consecutive terms. The dataset covers eight terms (4th - 11th). [numeric]

### party

Party acronym. [character]

#### full name

Full name in the local language. [character]

#### established

Year of the establishment. [numeric]

#### chairman

Chairman (usually the head of the party; sometimes the acting leader) [character]

#### ideology LR

Left - Right ideology scale (1-5): (1) left — (2) center-left — (3) center — (4) center-right — (5) right. [numeric]

#### party family

Party family affiliation (1-9): (1) Christian Democrats/Conservatives; (2) Social Democrats; (3) Liberals; (4) Greens; (5) Left Socialists; (6) Right-wing (populists); (7) Far-right (extreme-right); (8) Regionalist; (9) Minorities. [numeric]

#### election result

Election result for a party in the parliamentary election (%). [numeric]

## no seats

The number of seats a party received in the parliament after the election. [numeric]

#### coalition

Dummy variable for running in coalition: (1) yes; (0) no. [numeric]

## $coalition\_composition$

Members of the coalition. [character]

## ruling

Dummy variable for being part of the ruling coalition (1) or not (0). *Note for the 9th term*: G17 Plus and ZZŠ (as members of URS) were part of the government from 27 July 2012 to 2 September 2013. [numeric]
