Different scale factors!




#### the 5 OBJECTIVES

- OB.3 Increasing and enhancing the digitization of Cultural Heritage to support conservation
- OB.4 develop best practices to make full use of CH data for the benefit of the Cultural Heritage sector and in other domains
- OB5 define the operational, financial and legal conditions for the creation of the Competence Centre

  - cutting edge technologies









#### **4CH: Active WPs**
