

RDA builds the social and technical bridges that enable open sharing and reuse of data.







## Interest Groups [3 examples]

#### Social Science Research Data IG

Exchange on issues particular relevant to social sciences and humanities

### **Ethics and Social Aspects of Data**

Ethical & social issues regarding data archiving, sharing, and reuse.

### RDA/NISO Privacy Implications of Research Data Sets

Relevant for social science researchers working with personal data.

Note that a **Sensitive Data IG** is in group revision.



## Working Groups [3 examples]

### Discipline-Specific Guidance for DMPs WG

WG working on proposals for discipline-specific adaptations for DMP templates in various disciplines.

### RDA COVID-19 [SocialSciences]

WG providing guidelines on data sharing under the present COVID-19 circumstances.

### RDA/WDS Publishing Data Workflows WG

WG concerned with data publishing and the analysis of existing and emerging workflows and standards for data publishing.







