## **About the Central system**

The Central bibliometric research system is to be used by the National and University Library (NUL) and other libraries from the Croatian science and higher education system to conduct bibliometric analyses for their institutions, individual scientists and journal editors.


### **System structure**

With NUL's internal system around 1000 requests (scientists, journal editors) are processed yearly.

The role of the new system is to harmonize practice, provide support and education to libraries in the implementation of bibliometric services and other activities in the evaluation of scientific research and scientific productivity of their institutions.

The system consists of the online portal **bibliometrija.nsk.hr** and an **internal ticketing system** for librarians who use it.

The portal is intended for end users of bibliometric services: institutions' administrators, scientists, editors and publishers of scientific journals and other interested stakeholders in science and higher education. It consists of a form for submitting requests for various bibliometric certificates and analyses, educational materials and information.
