### SURVEY

- 19.5% did not fully understand what open access was
  - 15.5% thought open access meant 'not peer reviewed'
  - **15%** were not aware of the benefits of open access
- 18.2% equated charging an APC with predatory publishing
  - 48% did not know about the different tiers of open access publishing
    - 26% equated open access with predatory publishing
- 34.5% did not know what an APC was and what it should cover
- 50% did not know that authors retain the copyright

#### SET GOALS AND PROVIDE SUPPORT FOR OUR STAKEHOLDERS





- Establish policies
- Improve metadata and discoverability
- Improve accessibility and ease of access
- Support the reallocation of subscription funds
- Investigate supporting technological infrastructure
- Becoming hubs for training (eg copyright advice and information literacy, predatory practices etc)
- Advocate for open science to staff, researchers and wider networks

- Work to establish national and regional consortia to negotiate with publishers
- Support the creation of a regional pre-print repository
- Participate in cross-border collaborations and stakeholder strategy sessions
