


National Digital Library in the COVID mode: (1. 2. 2021 – 30. 6. 2021)


- ➤ Government Resolution No. 238, March, 1st 2021, on making the National Digital Library accessible for the purposes of education, science and research as a substitute for restrictions on library services due to the COVID 19
- Licence agreements for authors Dilia and OOA-S
- Accepted by the Association of Czech booksellers and publishers
- Costs: 80 000 000 CZK = 3 240 000 EUR / 6 months of the free access
- Payment procedures realized in the cooperation with National Library of the Czech Republic and DILIA + OOA-S



Usability of the digital content: November 2020 - June 2021:

43.4 million pages viewed in 8 months

Real usability of the digital libraries of NL CR, Moravian Library Brno and Academy of Sciences
Library from November 2020 to June 2021: In Total 43,4 milion pages displayed





- available documents:
 - Periodicals published until 2011 remote access
 - Books published until 2001 remote access
 - ➤ Books published between 2002 and 2007 in-house access
 - > Available in total 164 000 volumes
- annual payment for this licence (transferred via the National Library of the Czech Republic)
- > only the author receives the payment

Why the publishers were afraid to allow this solution?

- ➤ The free online distribution of the books published after 1989 is a strong threat to the titles available in the book market with sale potential and paid electronic services provided by the publishers.
- Every new book, author, topic can have its own competitive title avaiable on the market - professional literature, older textbooks, novels...
- ➤ Remote and free online access to DNNT books can compete with the latest paid titles on the market. This process can reduce sales possibilities.




Books published between 2002 and 2007 – in-house access

- > in the testing operation from 1st January 2022
- access via secured PC terminals
- mandatory duties of the involved libraries:
 - to prevent the abuse by the user
 - > PC has to be located in the public space
 - both print and digital copies making is strictly prohibited
 - > to take photos of the screen is also forbidden



DNNT INDEX

Running process

- ALEPH library catalogue internal database
- communication with the system is running via the transfer of csv/xls files
 - ➢ libraries are sending proposals for including works to curators by e-mail in this form
 - publishers can request for exclusion
- ➤ the index contained (data from 1. 2. 2022) 489 001 monographs published up to 2007, 33 841 periodicals titles published up to 2011 and 61 450 works proposed for inclusion in total
- the database is compared once a week against the databases of the largest Czech distributors
 - works newly available on the market are eliminated after that
 - > so far, 11 731 titles have been removed after the publishers' requests and manual checks against distributors' databases


New system - architecture

- ➤ testing procedures are closed now 1. 8. 2022 new system will be running
 - NoSQL ApacheSolr database
 - based on the API and OAI-PMH protocols support
 - UI framework based on the Angular solution
 - open source development: https://github.com/NLCR/SeznamDNNT
 - direct connection to library system and to the digital library
 - all the workflows and connections will be updated



Next steps?


- to be involved in the European database of the out of commerce works (https://euipo.europa.eu/ohimportal/ en)

- opening of an expert discussion on the modification of the copyright law






