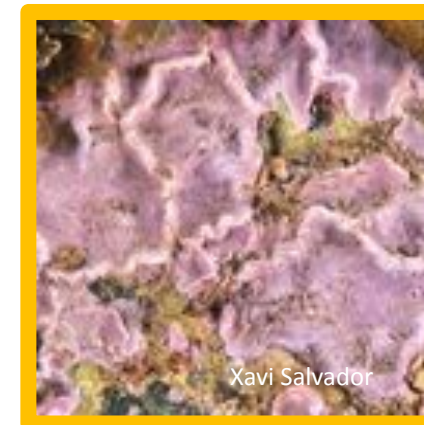
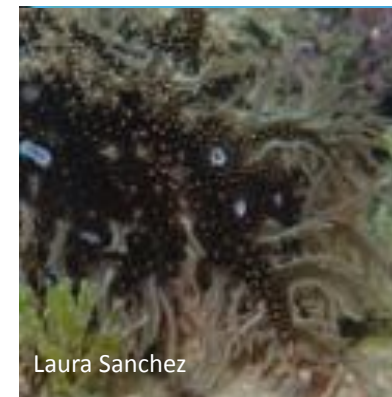
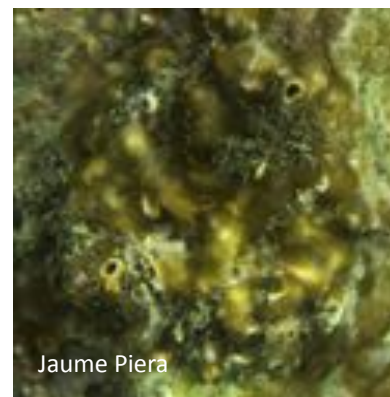
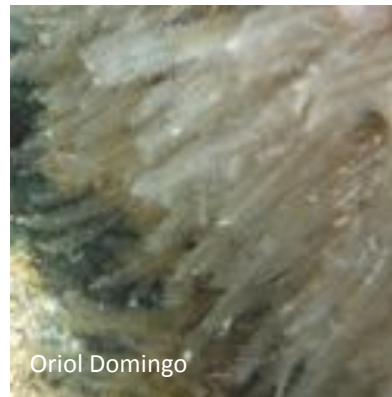
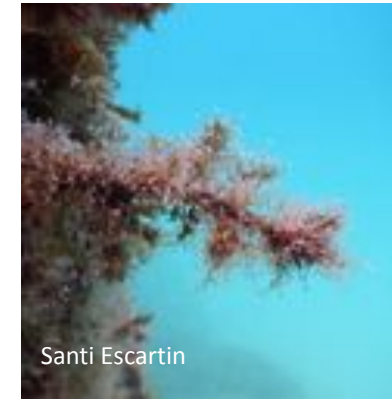
We need to promote a "***Marine Community***" and this involves us overcoming two major challenges:
