

Objective: The central aim of this poster is to describe the development of a virtual resources library with specialized contents on the field of cardiovascular diseases, organized according to a faceted organisation of categories.

Results: Without a doubt one of the most important aspects for the quality of information resources is the **accuracy of the retrieval of the contents**, avoiding the silence and the documental noise. The faceted classification methodology has shown us the possibility to **deal with more than one category** and so the possibility to increase the relevancy of the search results.
