- It originated under the name of MIC, but because there was another organization with the same name, it was renamed Ingenia.


#### Mentor committee




- It originated as a mentor body for teachers and collaborators, current students and prospective students of the ENIC (high school).
- It developed a virtual mentoring network that was in session even during 2020-2021.
- A new group arose from this effort: SACBÉ-ITESM, aimed at public school students and with the support of ITESM students who, through this means, have the option of accrediting their social service.















#### Possible links with W-STEM


- V stem
- Opportunity areas were analyzed to strengthen its presence internationally and with greater involvement of student groups.
- The difficulty in its consolidation was that some aspects of MIC were redefined, evolving into Ingenia and changing the board of directors, which left previous agreements weak.
- The pandemic continued to be a factor to overcome during the process, since all the face-to-face service windows became virtual, which modified their workload and, therefore, service.
