




### **PSSOH**


- Started in 2018




# Registered participants




# Gender (2020 and 2021)




# Age (2020 and 2021)







## Downloads on September 18, 2022




# Views by document type

### More numbers?

- Number of views of full papers is higher (14745) in comparison with documents without full papers (11305).
- Repositories with presentations were viewed more times (14361) in comparison with those without presentations (11689).
- On average, documents in Serbian were viewed 235.8 times being less in comparison to documents in English 321.6.
