




- **v2.0**
 - EC project FPs
 - Extended namespace [?](#) generic way of expressing project identification
- **v3.0**
 - The EC “Horizon Europe” FP.
 - Linking of publications to other publications (references), and to datasets.
- **v4.0**
 - Dublin Core and DataCite schemas.
 - New OAI-metadataPrefix: “oai_openaire”.
 - New schema namespace: "oaire" with additional elements
 - Identifier schemes for authors, organizations, funders, scholarly resources
 - COAR Controlled Vocabularies.
 - Compliance with the OpenAIRE Content Acquisition Policy.



It was highlighted during International Open Access Week.
