



Python Boolean types





What is a Boolean?

A simple data type in Python is the Boolean. It has only two possible values:

True

False

Comparisons result in Boolean values:

$$(3 > 5) == False$$

$$(2 == 2.0) == True$$





Tests in if/while result in a Boolean

```
if x > 3: # Will run if (x > 3) is True ...do something...
```

```
while my_list: # Will loop until my_list is empty ...something or other...
```

Note: Boolean values are case-sensitive!

```
True # not true
```

False # not false
