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APPLICATION OF PEDAGOGICAL TECHNOLOGIES IN TEACHING FOREIGN LANGUAGE

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In our society, the demand for using a foreign language in everyday life and learning a language using interactive methods is increasing. Different interactive methods give students the opportunity to learn not only the foreign language, but also the linguistic and cultural aspects of the country where the language is being studied, as well as the opportunity to interact, because they provide a strong and clear picture of how the language is integrated into the social and cultural context. oday, in a number of developed countries, methods that form the basis of great experience in the use of modern pedagogical technologies guaranteeing the effectiveness of the educational process are being used under the name of interactive methods. Interactive educational methods are currently the most common and are widely used in all educational institutions. Interactive methods are currently widespread and are considered to be one of the most widely used methods in all educational institutions. At the same time, there are many types of interactive educational methods, suitable for the purposes of implementing almost all tasks of the educational process. This includes the development of skills and the ability to use the lexicon learned in the classroom, i.e. discussion, and the ability to use it correctly in real situations.
