- The reports indicate the need for and importance of training, but do not indicate the steps that could be taken to start training.

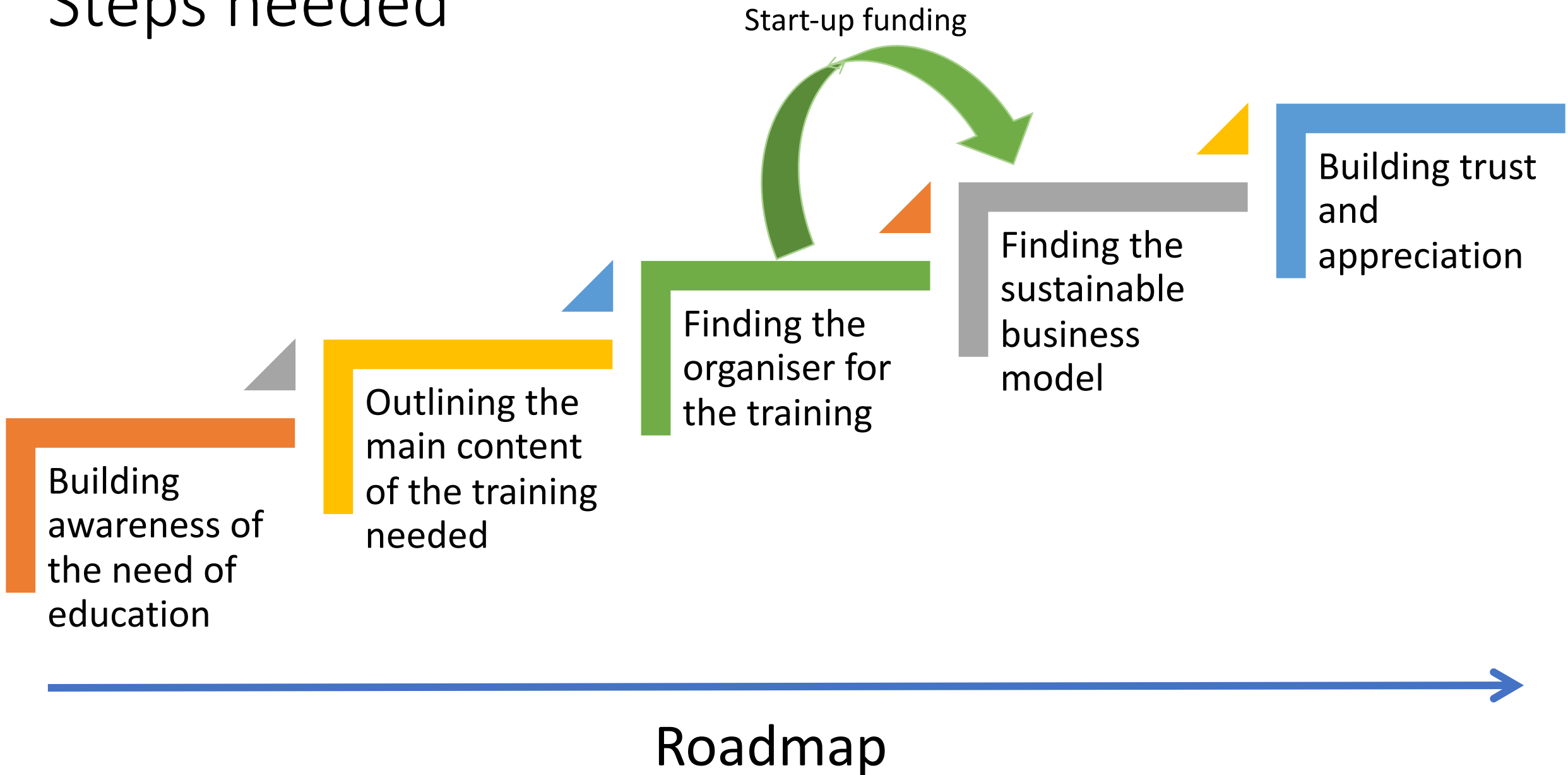
How to get from pointing out the problems towards the solution?

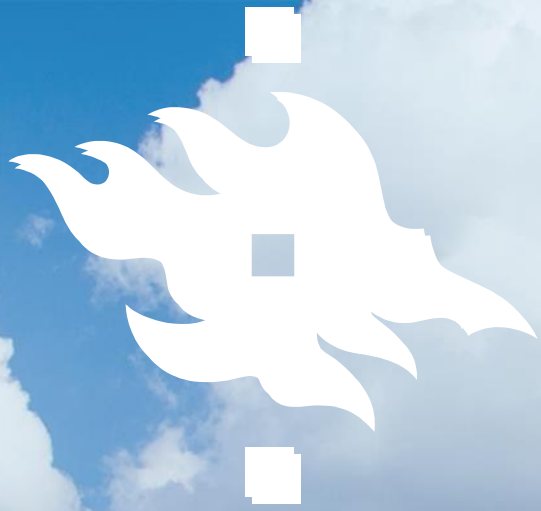
More actions, less reports
