Description

SEM images of each specimen were used to digitalize landmarks, with digitization

performed using TpsDig2 v. 2.25 (Rohlf 2016). A combination of landmarks and

semilandmarks or sliding landmarks were used, for analysing homologous points locations

together with curves measured on a sample of organisms. Principal component analysis

(PCA) was subsequently applied to explore the overall diversity of within-sample shape

variation using software PAST v. 2.13 (Hammer et al. 2001).
