- Partners are a mix of researchers, infrastructure specialists, legal experts
- DELAD organises annual workshops since 2015 where these groups convene

DELAD Background

- Second CLARIN-DELAD Workshop, Utrecht NL, SURF premises, 28-29 Jan. 2019
 - Reaffirmation that CLARIN is the Data Trust, to provide the data fence around CSD.
 - DELAD should apply to become a Task Force within CLARIN focusing on practical issues on sharing CSD.
 - As a result, the DELAD website should be updated with a CLARIN flag and contain relevant guidelines for collecting, sharing and storing CSD.
 - Talkbank is seen as a good CLARIN site to host CSD, especially if a European storage cloud and stricter access policy can be realised.
 - Collaboration DELAD, ACE, TLA, Talkbank in data curation
- Third CLARIN-DELAD Workshop, Online 27-28 Jan. 2021
 - Extend DELAD network with new participants
 - Explore with the participants the potential of the new CLARIN K-Centre on Atypical Communication Expertise (henceforth ACE) for hosting CSD of DELAD members
 - Exchange deeper insights on Data Protection Impact Assessments (DPIAs),
 - Discuss voice conversion as a means to pseudonymize speech
