Why share raw data?

 Teaching: speech-language pathology, special education, other health professions

Research

Public education

Informed Consent

- Ethics: Obligation (no!); Encouragement/Coercion (no)
- Levels of Consent
 - Organizations of researchers data collection, agencies
 - Individual parent/caregiver
 - What about the child at the time (assent) and later?
- Agency/community consent does not equal individual consent, BUT
- Can an individual consent when the agency has not? The researcher cannot initiate the consent process, but what if the individual does?
- Levels of Consent
 - Anonymized written material, transcriptions
 - Anonymized sound files
 - Anonymized video files or still images
- Can consent transfer from Phonbank to DELAD if DELAD/CLARIN have not been explicitly mentioned?

Types of Data I Crosslinguistic Project

- Single-word speech samples (80-100 words) transcribed in Phon: from an international crosslinguistic project (since 2006) with children with typical versus protracted phonological development (speech 'sound' disorders): 16 languages (varying numbers of participants/language)
 - Some shared in Phonbank (Talkbank): Icelandic, English, European Portuguese, Granada Spanish (others planned)
 - · Cross-sectional single-point samples; some longitudinal (treatment studies)
 - phonodevelopment.sites.olt.ubc.ca (test materials, activities...)
- · Adult models for the dialect/language
- Files: orthography, IPA targets and child pronunciations
 Linked audio-recordings (not English)

Types of Data II

- Typical English-speaking adult
- Ultrasound videos of English speech sounds, how to use ultrasound in speech therapy, aimed at public
 - Linked sound files

- Could this be linked and annotated for DELAD?

Types of Data III

- Typical French-speaking adults
 - Transcribed sound files: orthography, IPA targets and pronunciations
 - Schlieren images/videos: typical nasalized/non-nasalized vowels (within words)
 - Currently not being shared anywhere but there is secondary consent for future data analysis and teaching purposes
