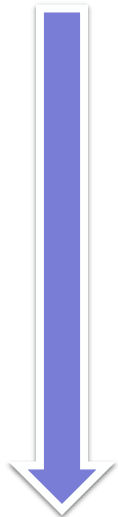

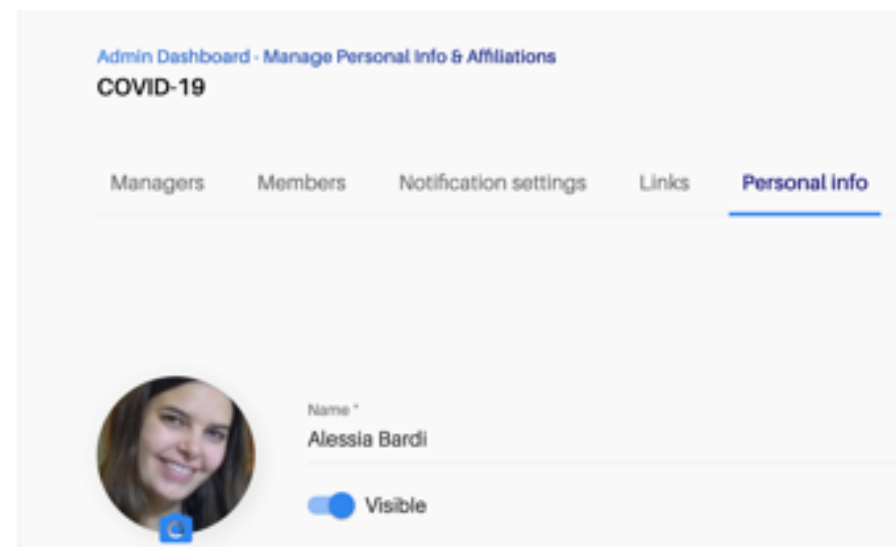
BEFORE

1. You are not listed among the curators if you have not filled in your short bio
2. If you filled in your short bio you are in the list of curators. If you do, you cannot hide yourself anymore

NOW

1. You are not listed among the curators if you have not filled in your short bio
2. If you filled in your short bio you AND you decide to be visible, then you are in the list of curators.
3. If you change your mind, you can hide yourself

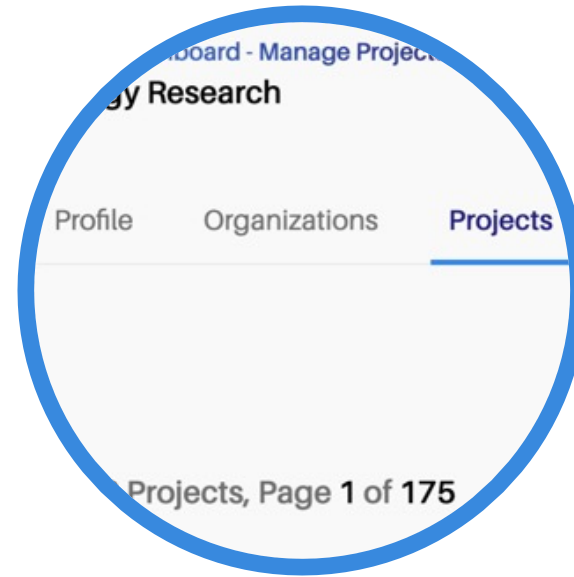

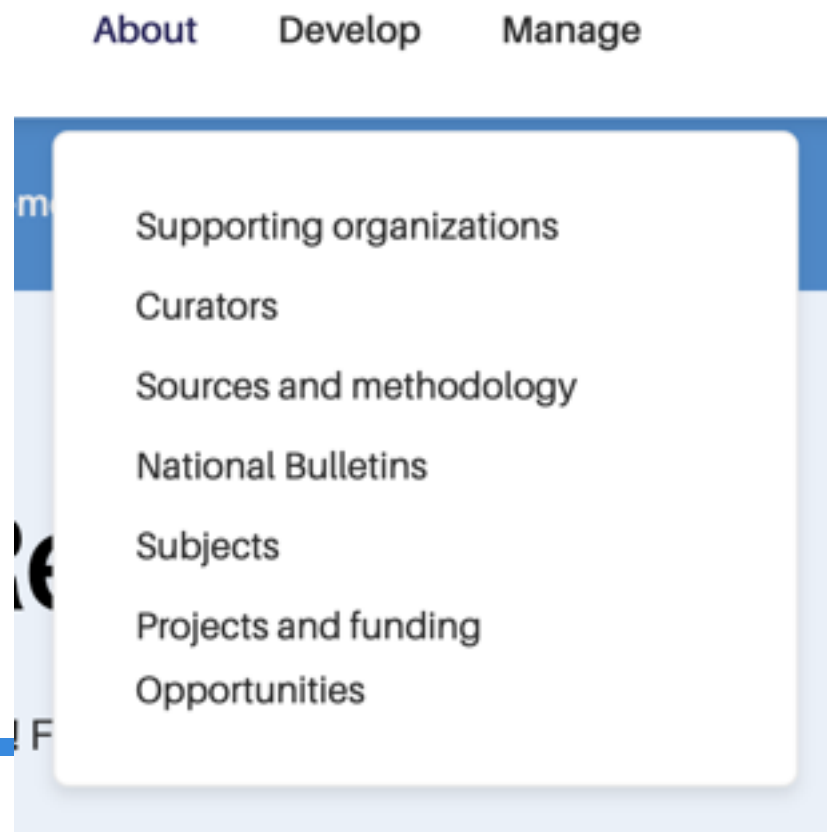
