Targum

Psa. 87:1 Uttered by the sons of Korah. A song that was established at the instruction of the fathers of old. ² The LORD loves the entrances to the academies established in Zion more than all the synagogues of the house of Jacob. ³ Glorious words have been spoken of you, O city of God, forever. ⁴ The Egyptians and Babylonians have reminded those who know you of your praises; behold, the Philistines and Tyrians, with the Ethiopians; this king was brought up there. ⁵ And of Zion it will be said, "King David and Solomon his son were brought up within it; and God shall build it above." ⁶ O LORD, in the book in which they write the account of all the ages [it is written], "This king was brought up there forever." ⁷ And they utter songs with celebration – all kinds of psalms with sacrifice are uttered in your midst.

Spiritual Awareness

Introduction

Korach ran an unsuccessful revolt against Moses (Number 16). He felt he was superior to Moses, Aaron, and Israel's other leaders. He refused to recognize that the Land of Israel is holier than any other land in the world. Korach's sons refused to join their father in his revolt. Instead, they composed this Psalm to extol the unique virtues of the Land of Israel and the city of Jerusalem.

Verse three

They are honored through Him, Who is proclaimed within You, O city of God. Meditate on this verse.

Verse six

It was believed that the LORD had a book that listed people who had labored for the welfare of their own people. It was a short list for every nation.

The LORD counts when He registers peoples; This one was born there. Meditate on this verse.
