





The German National Library and the Bielefeld University Library enabled the "claiming" of works and developed "Search&Link" claiming services, which helps researchers, especially in German-speaking countries, to discover and connect with their activities from within their ORCID record.

V. Fazit und Empfehlungen

Die datenschutzrechtliche Begutachtung von ORCID hat keine gravierenden Mängel feststellen können. Im Gegenteil, das System unterstützt mit seinen Privacy-Funktionalitäten die Nutzerinnen und Nutzer bei der Ausübung ihres Rechts auf informationelle Selbstbestimmung und hat diesbezüglich stellenweise durchaus Vorbildcharakter. Durch die Konzipierung als Nutzerkontrolliertes Identitätsmanagementsystem können die Nutzer des Portals jederzeit einsehen und kontrollieren, welche Daten wie auf der Plattform verarbeitet

Foundation of the ORCID Germany Consortium

- October 1st, 2016 the German National Library of Science and Technology (TIB) and ORCID DE aim to join forces to develop and operate the ORCID Germany Consortium for research institutions in Germany
- 6 institutions, as initial members, enabled the signing of the consortium agreement by TIB and ORCID
- By 30 November 2016, the 12 institutions had additionally joined the ORCID Germany Consortium as founding members



ORCID DE 2 2020 to 2022

- 2. Funding Phase from 2020 to 2022 (Application (only in German))
- Project's Aims
 - Expansion and Consolidation of the established network of scientific institutions that have implemented ORCID.
 - 2. Professionalize the consulting activities for institutions or target groups
 - Support the development of an identification system for organizations that are linked to ORCID.







4. RESULTS

The results of the survey are presented in what follows according to the four sections of the questionnaire.


4.1. GENERAL

With regard to the participation of the different institution types, higher education institutions (universities and universities of applied sciences) accounted for more than half of the participants. The nonuniversity research institutions (Helmhottz centers, Leibniz institutes, Max Planck institutes, and the federal government's departmental research institutions) together accounted for a share of almost one third. The question was mandatory and was answered by 183 institutions (see Figure 1).




Recipients of the survey invitation were mainly either persons in senior positions at the libraries of the respective institutions or contact persons for electronic publishing or open access/open science. Increponse to the question, 'fluwhat function within your institution are you participating in this survey?,' a large majority (81.4%; n=149) answered 'as a library staff member.' By controst, research and teaching staff (3.3%; n=7), administrative staff (3.3%; n=6), data center staff (1.6%; n=3), and university press staff (1.1%; n=2) participated only to a small extent in the survey. Further functions were reported under 'Other' (8.7%; n=16), for example, 'data manager,' 'RIS [research information system] officer,' and 'information management.' The question was mandatory and was answered by 183 institutions (see Figure 2).
