- To achieve full understanding of the primacy of human rights and freedoms, the supremacy of the Constitution and the law. For this purpose, the state should support the publication and distribution of popular scientific legal literature by providing the young generation with legal information, according to their age and individual characteristics and learning abilities.

- It is necessary to develop a modern system of legal education, personnel training and retraining. For this, it is necessary to improve the means and methods of legal education and legal education, and to increase the interest of the young generation in this field.

- organization of exhibitions on legal topics, etc

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
