

Interface for most extensive data curation:

- BookMetaHub
 - Import of DOI-based records and ONIX files
 - Data curation via User Interface
 - Export of Crossref-compatible XMLs and BITS XML
- Thoth
 - Data curation via User Interfaces
 - Export of various ONIX formats, KBART, CSV, JSON
- Easy interoperable solution for the creation of rich DIY metadata for (OA) books
- Increased discoverability and visibility for academic book publications
- Data flow between systems for more robust publishing ecosystem




