

The Publishers Learning And Community Exchange (PLACE) is an online public forum for organisations who wish to adopt best practices in scholarly publishing. Publishers can access information from multiple agencies in one place, ask questions of the experts and join conversations with each other.















Grant registration form

- Facilitates registration of grant metadata, even with no knowledge of XML
- Simple process: complete form, enter your credentials, receive instant confirmation of your submission
- https://beta.crossref.org/records
- Next iteration: expand on record types (articles, etc.)



Open website

- Moved to an open repository (<u>gitlab.com/crossref/crossref-website</u>).
- Fosters community co-creation (through issues and merge requests).
- Sets the stage for multilingual documentation.
- Supports our POSI promises of transparent ops and open code/data.



Preview of Relationships API endpoint

- Delivers links between metadata records.
- Combines member metadata with Event Data
- Better support for citations, funding data, and online commentary.
- <u>Preview</u> with sample data (10 million relationships) available now



How can you help - start adding context

- References
- Abstracts
- Corrections & retractions via Crossmark
- License links
- ORCID IDs for authors
- ROR IDs for affiliations

- Grant IDs for funder acknowledgements
- Cite data
- Register all related objects via relationships
- Register grants with Crossref (funder members).

Reference metadata at Crossref

- All references openly available since June 2022.
- 52.0% of journal articles, 44.5% of all works have references.
- Deposit options:
 - XML via HTTPS POST (structured or unstructured)
 - Simple Text Query (unstructured text)
 - OJS Plugin
- References to your works appear only if you deposit them!

- 49,951 records with ROR IDs


19,727,347 records with abstracts 64,275,131 records with references 76,759 grant records 2,632,398 dataset records

(preliminary) survey results




- Sent to all members, 921 responses so far

- Contributor IDs
- Contributor roles/ CRediT
- Alternate names
- Multilingual metadata
- Expand abstract support
- Citation types (content)

Other suggestions

New record types: maps, OER / undergraduate capstone papers / Research Reports from Master students / zines / book reviews / multimedia projects / comics / films / songs and music / performances / teaching materials / magazines / annual presentations / design, architecture, all humanities related objects / datasets / replication packages / supplemental materials to papers / videos / dynamic data visualizations (e.g. Tableau) / research modules

Identifiers: GND Person identifier for Austria, Germany and Switzerland / RAiD / Metadata identifiers related to music compositions (composer, genre, etc.)

Expand metadata: peer review info / contributor sequencing / geographical location and time period / author middle names / subjects / THEMA codes / digital preservation status / corresponding author / keywords / open access indicators / elocation ID



Other things on our radar

- ★ Statements: data availability, acknowledgements, etc.
- ★ Journal metadata: policies, editorial boards
- ★ Versioning
- ★ Preprints
- ★ Grants/funding data updates
