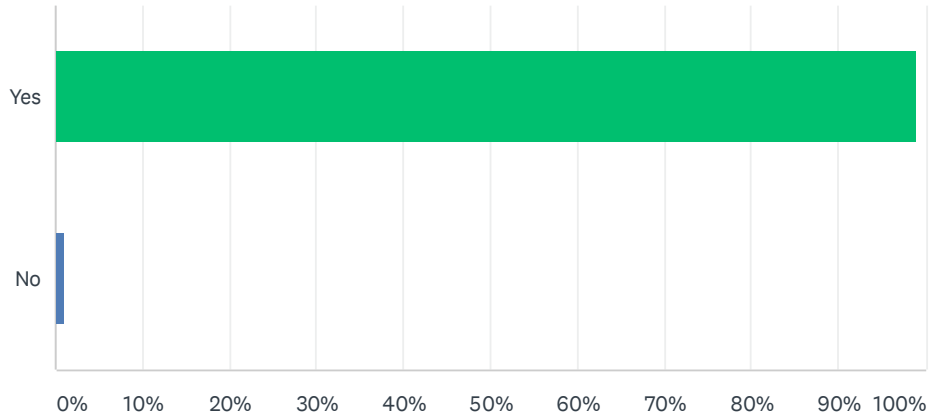


Q1 Do you consent to participate in this survey?

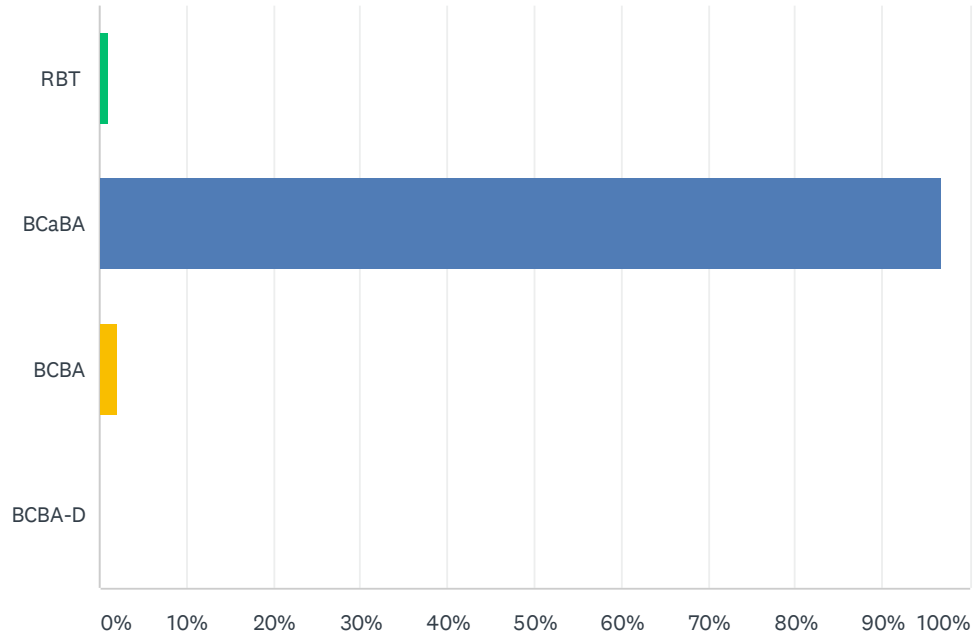

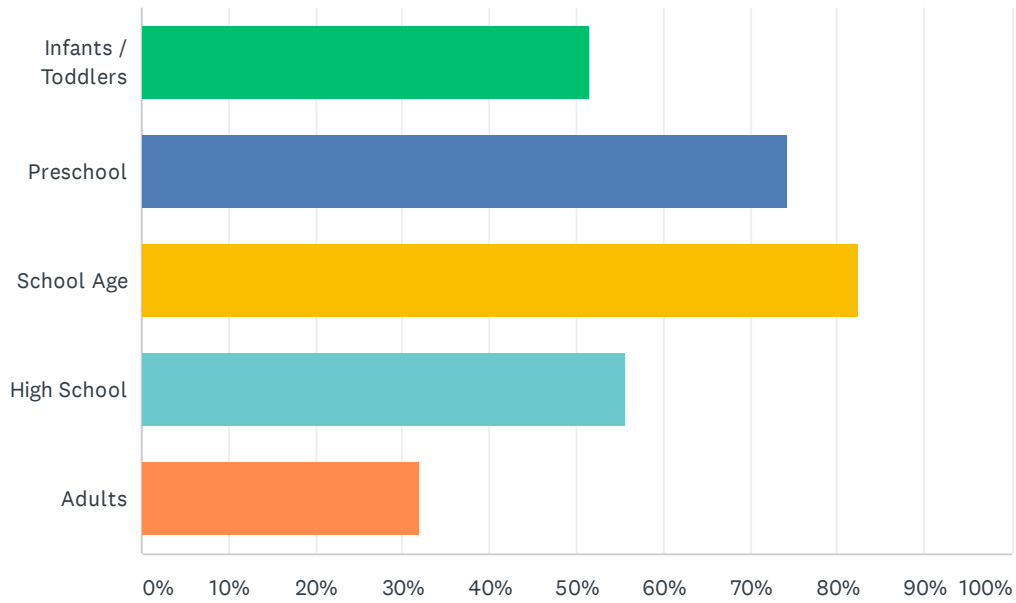

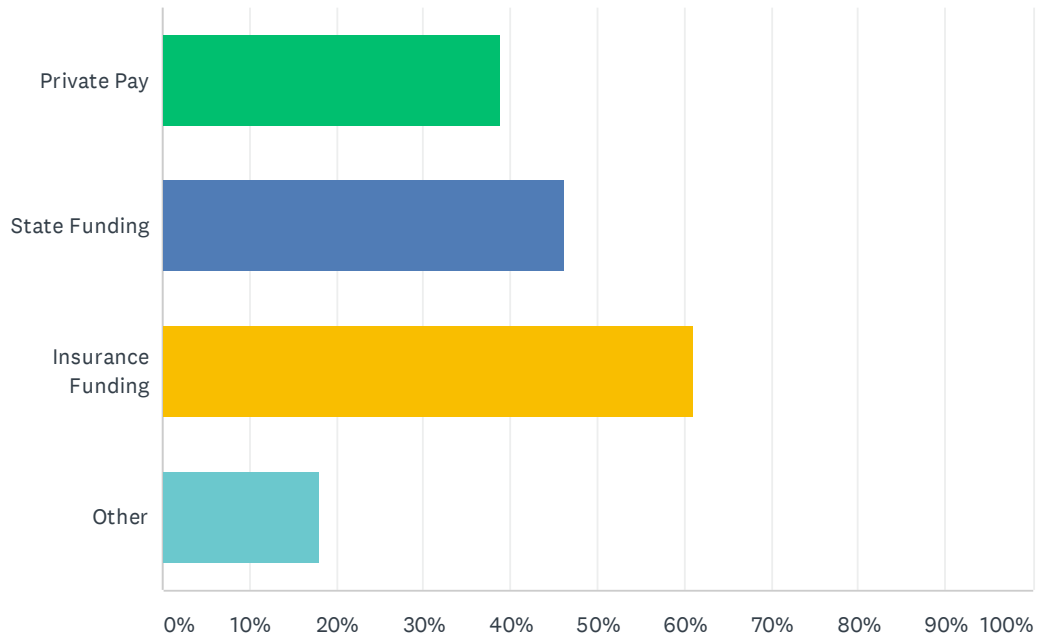

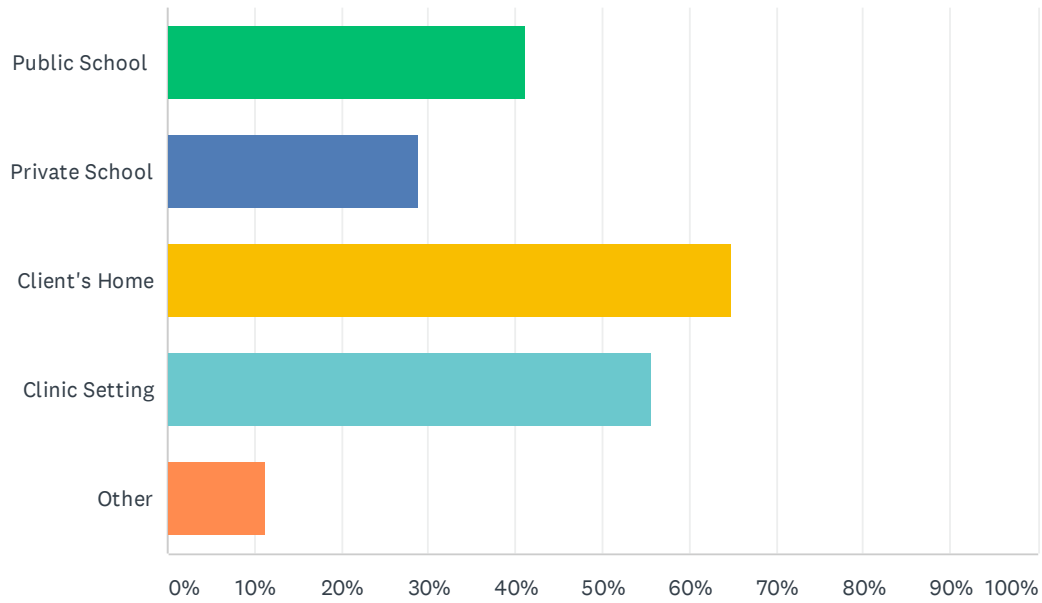

Q6 Treatment Location

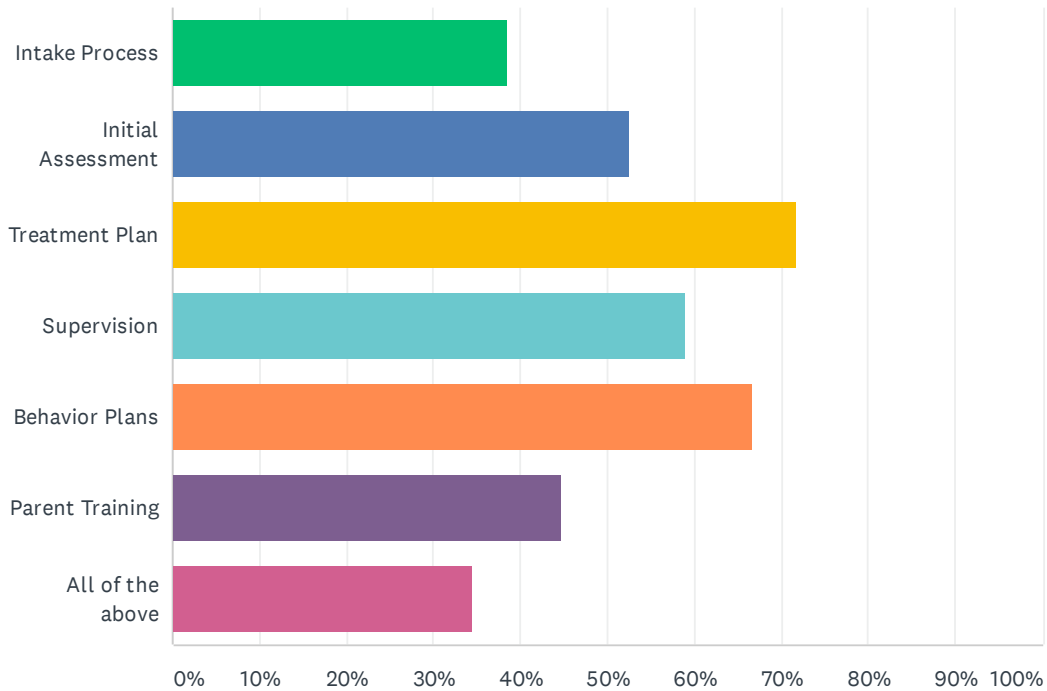

Q7 In what areas of treatment do you feel most competent?

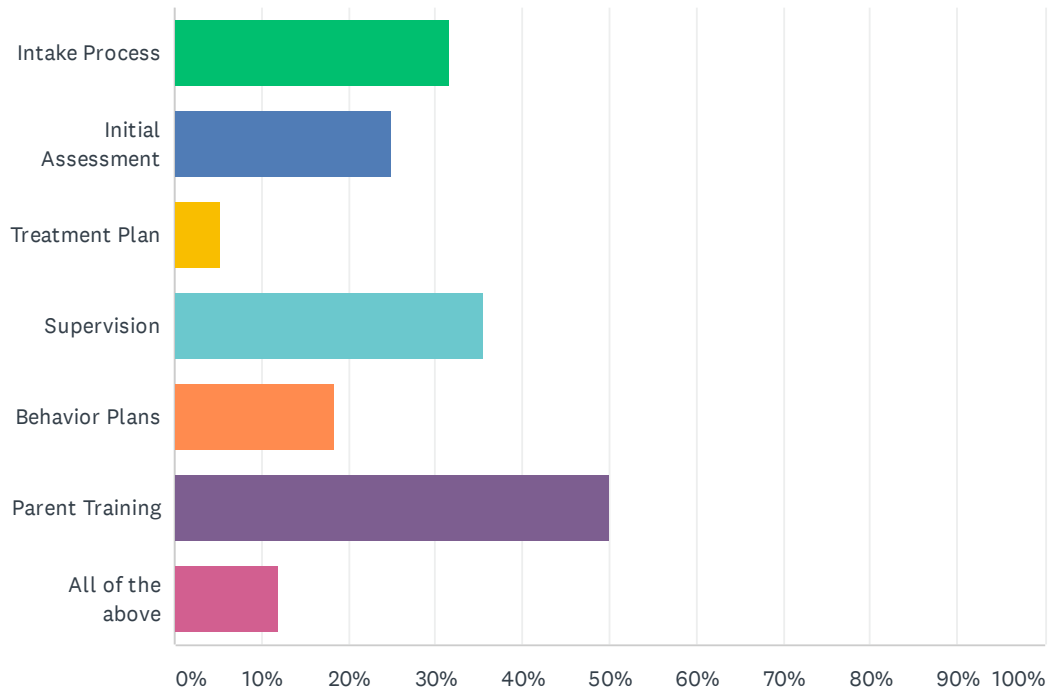

Q8 In what areas of treatment do you feel you can use more training?

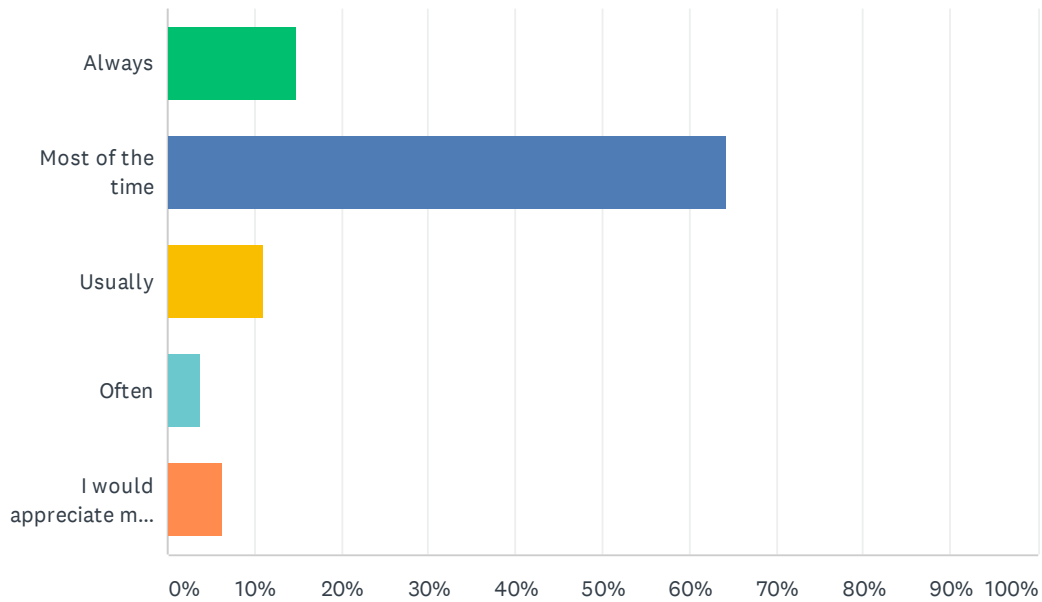

Q9 Do you feel equipped in knowing what skill deficits to target in your ABA treatment?

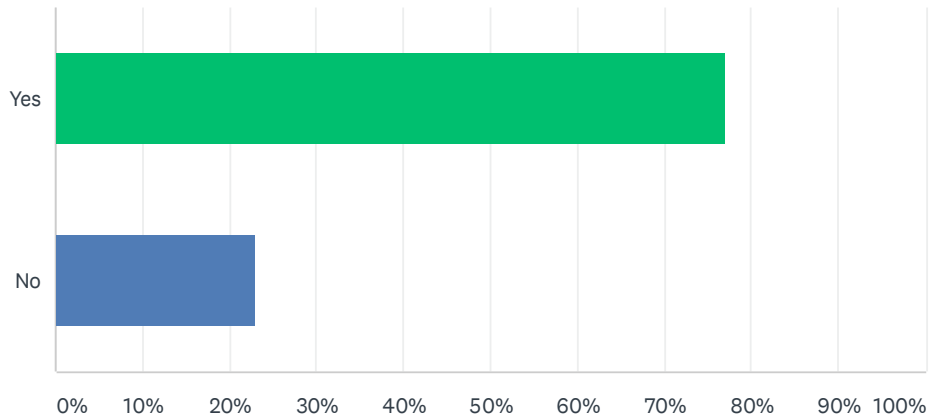

Q10 Do you feel your practice would benefit from research on the nervous system in Autism (neuroscience research) to enhance treatment planning and programs?

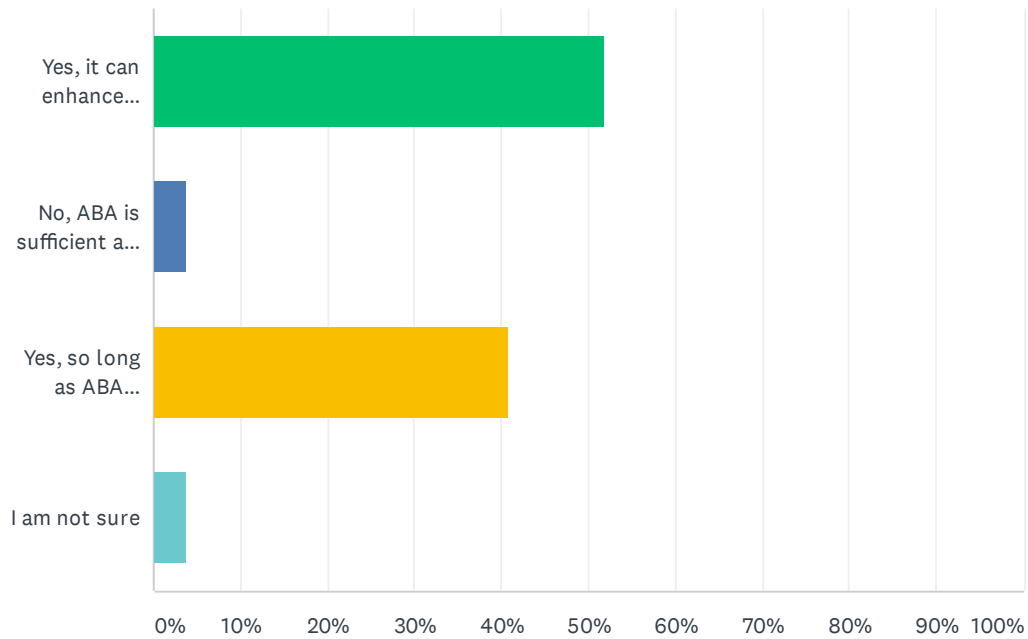

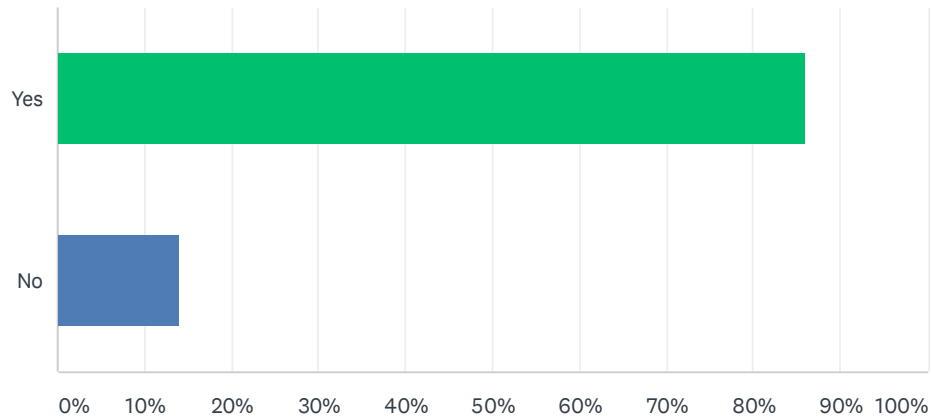

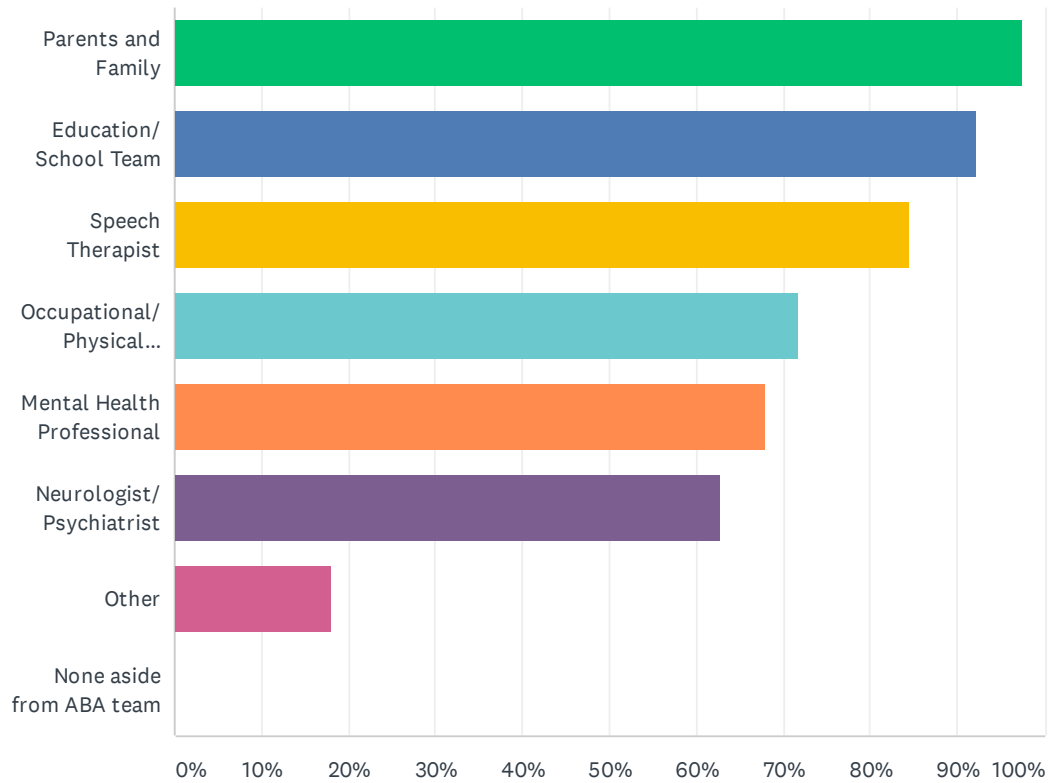
