


Supplementary information, Figure S2. The author demographics. Here, we provide background information on the authors of the manuscript. In panels A-B, the barplots represent how contributions were distributed among authors. The maps present the geographical distribution of the authors' institutions. Here, the yellow circle represents the location of the conference that initiated the manuscript. In panel G, the barplot represents collaborations with the first-author prior to the manuscript. Here, "Network" refers to collaboration via network publications, and "Close" refers to collaboration via other publications and projects.
