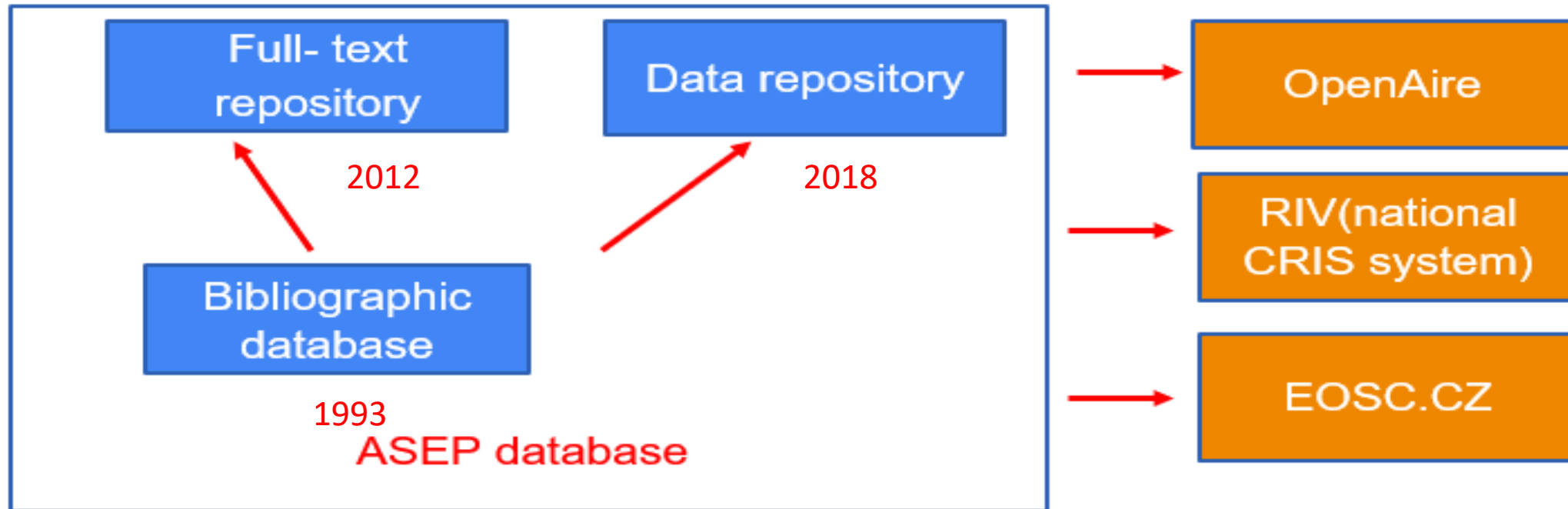

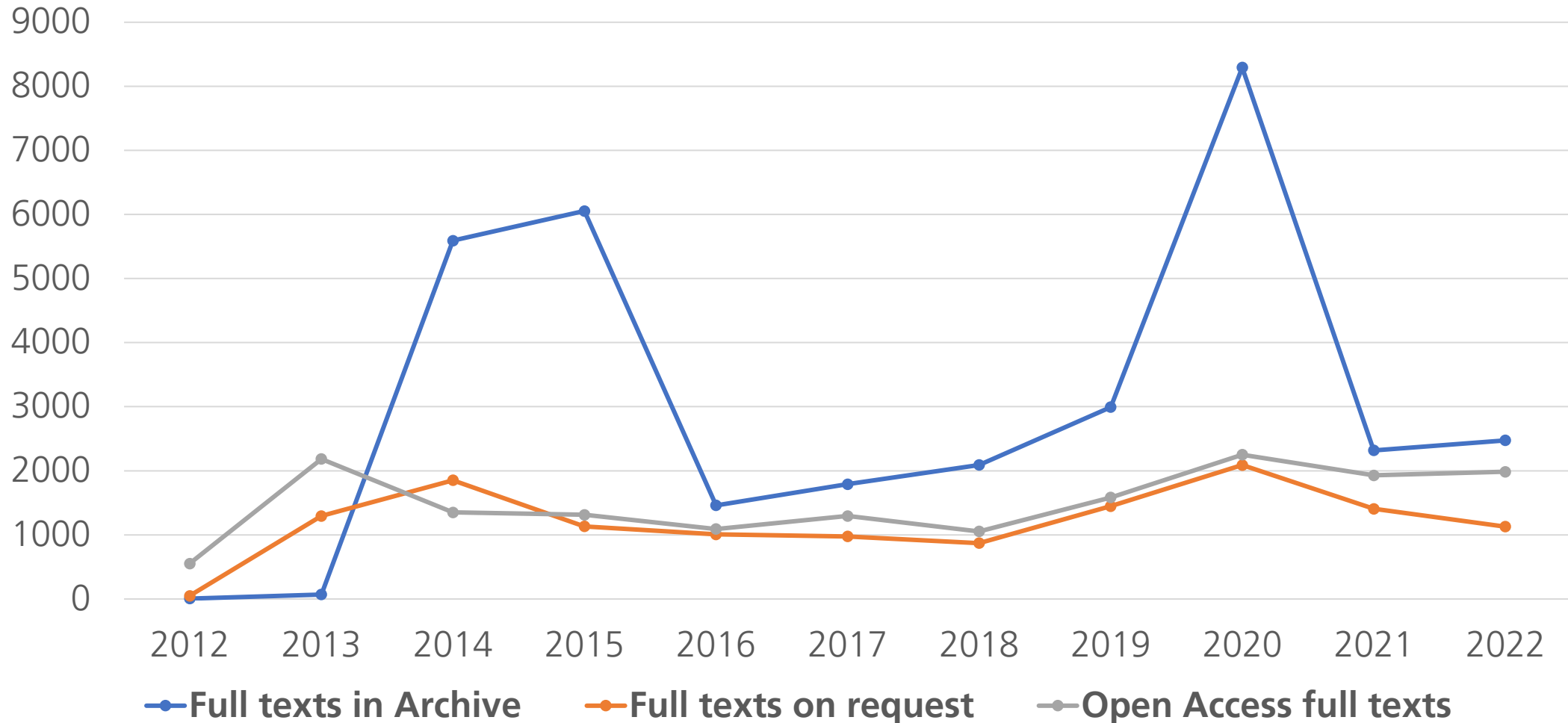
Czech Academy of Sciences

- The Czech Academy of Sciences (CAS) is a network of 54 public research institutions.
- With over 8,000 employees, CAS is a major research organization in the Czech Republic.
- CAS and its institutes conduct research across a wide range of fields, including the natural, technical, and social sciences, as well as the humanities.
- The Library of the Czech Academy of Sciences is a public research institution in Prague that supports the research activities of the CAS institutes by providing library, information, and digitization services and is also the provider of the **ASEP database and repository**.

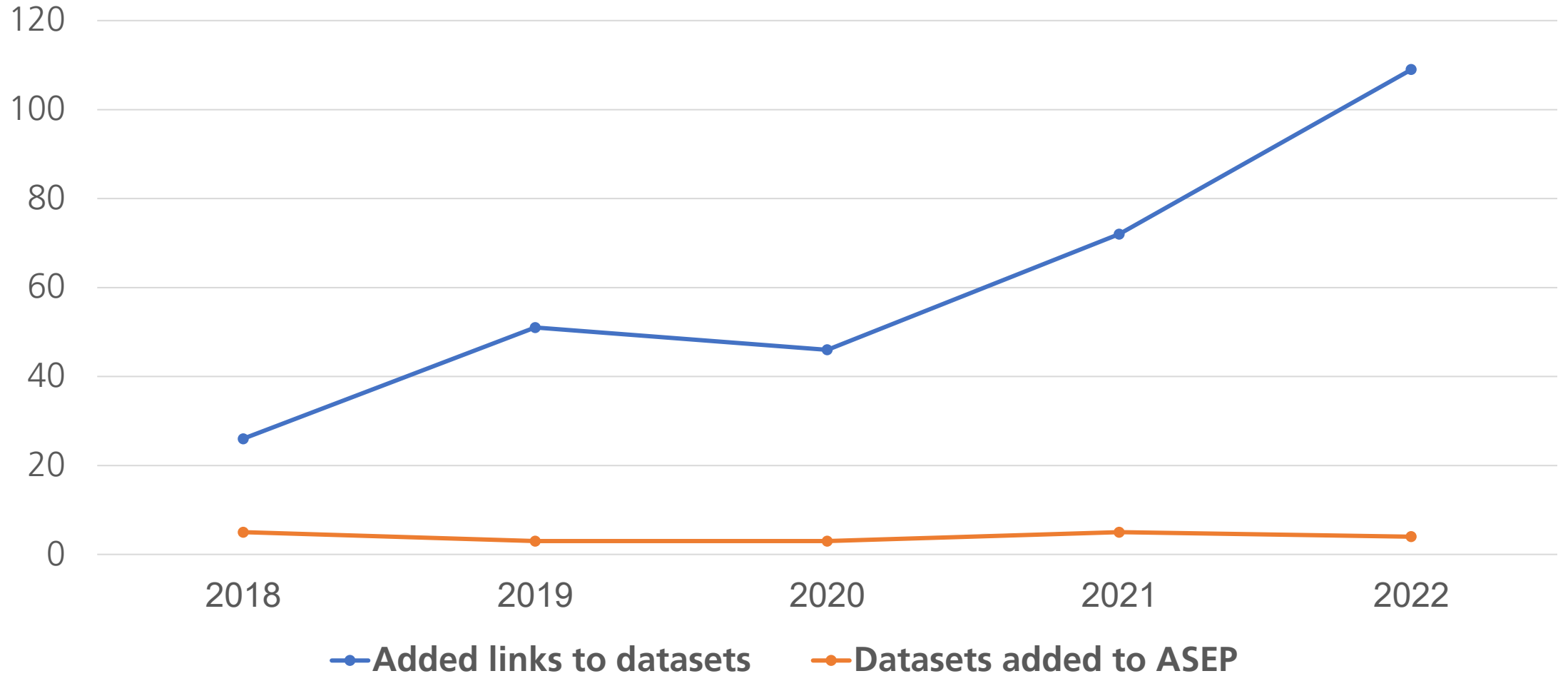
ASEP database

- We have created a data repository that meets the current requirements for long-term storage of scientific data and complies with FAIR principles.
- Changes in legislation, new funders requirements.
- We have several dozen data records in the data repository so far.
- Based on the behaviour of users of the full-text repository in the previous ten years, we expect an increase in the use of the data repository this year.
