

Additional data preparation and analysis details for *Looking in or out?: A bibliometric study of the interdisciplinarity of medical education research*.

1. To create counts for journals in the Cited References, we first created a journal thesaurus for Web of Science (WoS) indexed journals. This included the full journal name, and the journal's WoS abbreviation.
