 - Support the uptake of standards

- SBS experts: From 10% women in 2022 to 14% in 2023 (from 7% to 17% in ICT)
- More than 80 standards organisations have signed the <u>UNECE Declaration on</u> <u>Gender responsive standards</u> (including ISO, IEC, ITU,CEN and CENELEC)
- Guidance tools have been developed: <u>UNECE Guidelines on gender responsive</u> <u>standards</u>, <u>ISO- IEC Guide on Gender responsive standards</u>
- <u>AUWP 2023-</u>harmonised standards inclusive/gender-responsive –ensure anthropometric references are based on representative data for whole European population
