Welcome to Göttingen University Press

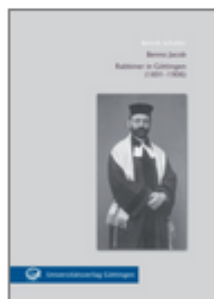

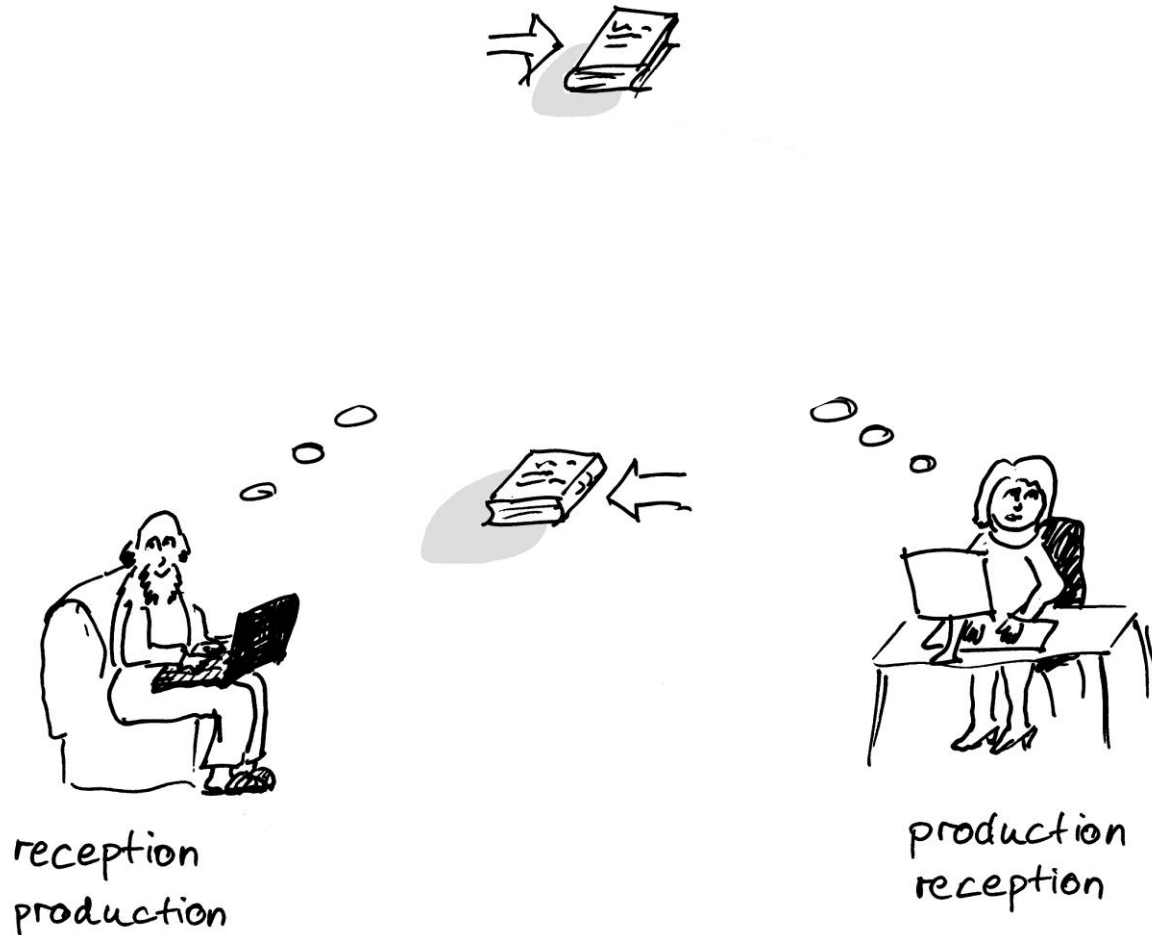


Functions of publications, does the press do its job?

Zhang Yibing's book is a serious inquiry into the complex interrelationships between Marx's political and economic philosophy. The author reflects on the interplay of philosophy, history and economics in the various phases of an unfolding theoretical system based throughout on a critique of capitalism.

This kind of coverage allows non-chinese readers insights into the Chinese reception and interpretation of the international discourse on Marx.

The author Prof. Dr. Zhang Yibing is chancellor of the Nanjing University. He teaches philosophy and is one of the foremost scholars of Marxism in China.

Different forms of Open Access

Primary publication (**Golden road**)

- Free access to primary source , usually with libre license allowing further usage
- Publication in a genuine and quality-controlled Open Access channel such as a journal, a book, an anthology
- „Gold Open Access“ covers the full value chain
- Funding on production side

Parallel publication (**Green road**)

- Free access to pre- or postprint or author's version
- Via subject-specific or institutional repositories
- Mostly organised and exercised by authors and their institution
- Funding of media products in the toll-access paradigm, funding of infrastructure via academia



Hybrid Open Access


- Author pays fee to free content from subscription barrier

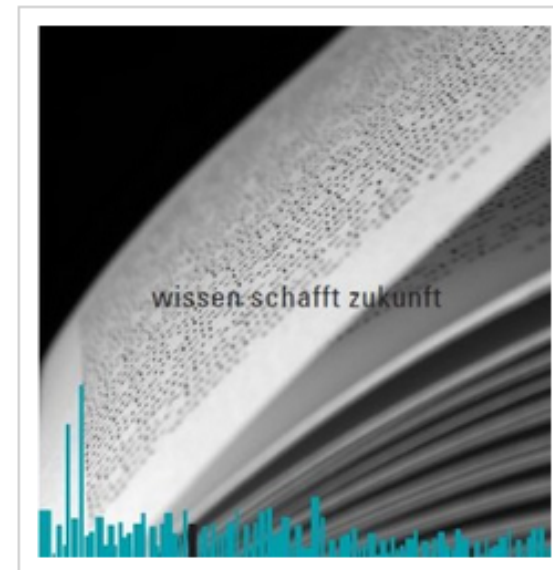

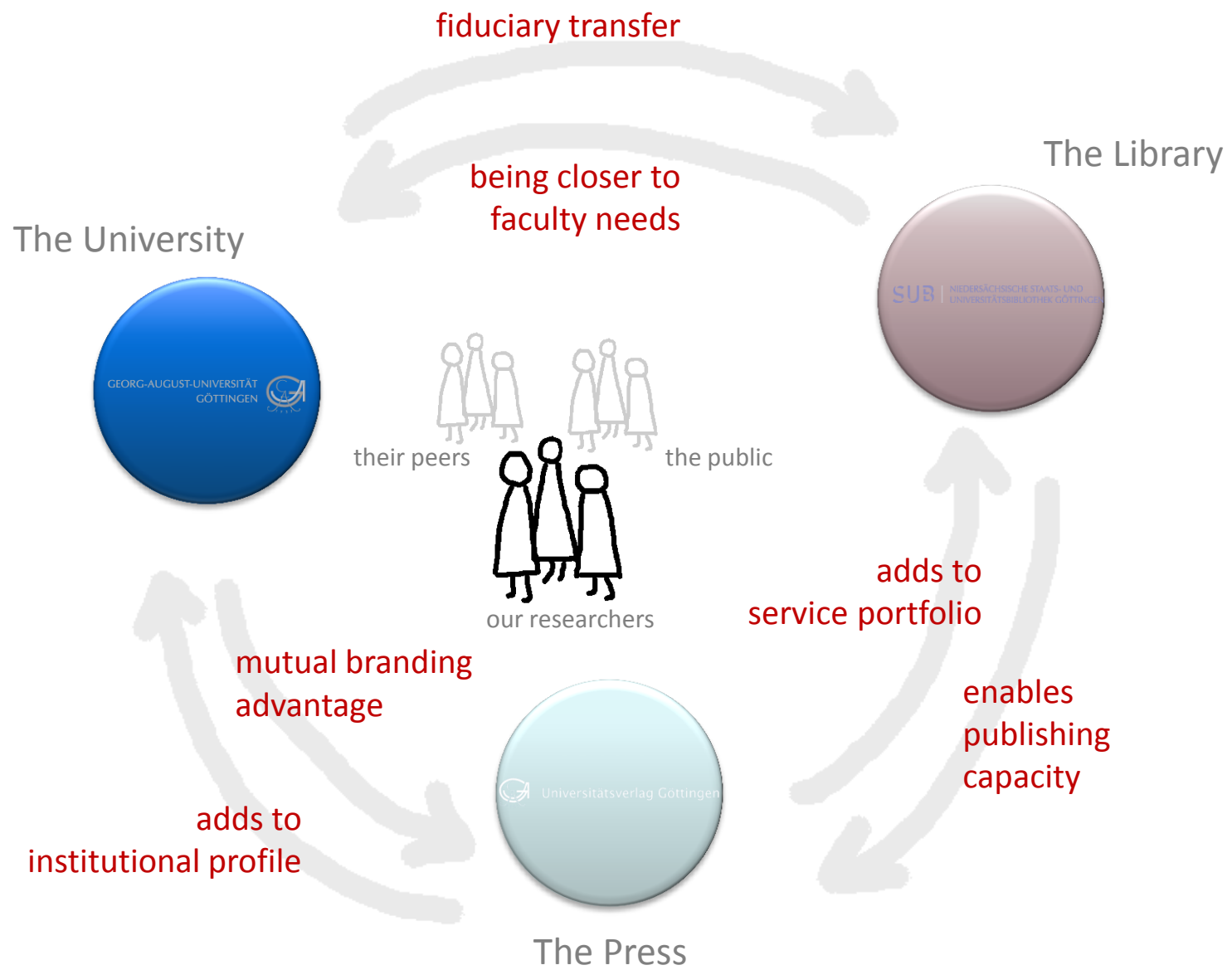

Göttingen University Press: Guidelines (Extracts)

- University's faculties appoint one or two members to the editorial board.
- Editorial board steers the University Press
 - programmatic orientation & quality assurance
- Research friendly usage and exploitation rights
 - non-exclusive right for the e-version
 - Exclusive rights for the print-version (but- publication elsewhere permitted)
- Publishing prices
 - There is a publication charge covering author support for manuscript preparation, formal quality assurance, artwork production, online deployment, title registration and marketing.
