**FAIRsharing acts as a trusted, curated source of the evolving landscape of databases and standards across disciplines**

**FAIRsharing supports your awardees to:**

 **Navigate** through the wealth of databases and standards, and their **relationships**, according to their data types and discipline

 **Discover** and **select** the right databases for **sharing** and disseminate their outputs

 **Learn** about the minimal information requirements, formats and persistent identifier schemas required for those databases

**To support FAIRsharing you can:**

 **Highlight** it in your data management guidelines and policies, providing examples of resources within your remit that you may want to recommend

 **Recommend** that awardees register their newly-developed databases and standards in FAIRsharing to improve their discoverability

 **Register** or claim your data policy in FAIRsharing, describing its content and scope (which digital objects it applies to), and any standards and databases recommended
