# **Tampere University Press (TUP)**

- Established in 1994, it is part of Tampere University Library.
- Publishes doctoral dissertations (Acta-series) and academic monographs (including edited collections) from various fields of study.
- Since 2000 most of the dissertations are available in Open Access on the TamPub portal in PDF format (year 2016: 96 %).
- TUP has published 332 books in all (excluding dissertations). About 70 % of them are available in Open Access at the moment.





#### New business model: Open Access

- From 2016 Tampere University Press profiled as a peerreviewed Open Access publishing channel and discontinued publishing printed books as a rule (except for dissertations).
- Tampere University Press is the first Open Access press in Finland.
- The books are published immediately on the open net, new printed books are not sold.
- TUP Open Access books are published on <u>TamPub</u> <u>portal</u> and also on international <u>OAPENLibrary portal</u>.
- TUP Open Access books have Creative Commons licenses since 2016.

#### **Quality validation**

- Manuscripts are peer-reviewed by two outside experts (double-blind peer review), selected by TUP Editorial Board members. TUP publishing director makes the final publishing decision, based on reviews and recommendations of the Editorial Board.
- TUP is rated at level 1 (basic level) in Finnish Publication Forum classification.





## Main challenges

- Funding: The costs of an Open Access book
  350 € fee + layout costs are charged from the author. Other costs of OA publishing are covered from the Library budget.
- Language: Most of the books published are in Finnish.
- Researchers' awareness of Open Access, authors still like to have printed books.
- Marketing: How to market Open Access books effectively?
